

Job description:

Year and student council representatives.

Students must be able to:

- 1. Represent their year group at school council meetings with commitment and full attendance.
- 2. Report back to their tutor groups following year council and wider school council meetings.
- 3. Believe in the importance of representing their year group's point of view even if they do not agree with it themselves.
- 4. Initiate discussion and debate with fellow student representatives and understand the importance of teamwork.
- 5. Understand that as a school council representative, they have the obligation to participate in making decisions about the school, along with staff and school governors.
- 6. Represent the students of Weatherhead High School at important public occasions.
- 7. Attend all school council and year council meetings. If there is a justifiable reason ensure that an adequate stand-in from their tutor/year group is present.
- 8. School council belongs to its representatives and is dependent on their initiative for its success.
- 9. Compile a half termly newsletter to inform staff and students about the school council and their role.
