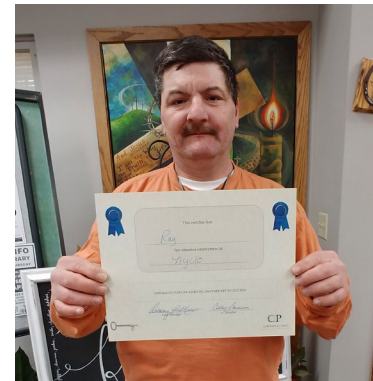

Tony is ready to hit the road in style with a new bike from our Cycles for Change program.



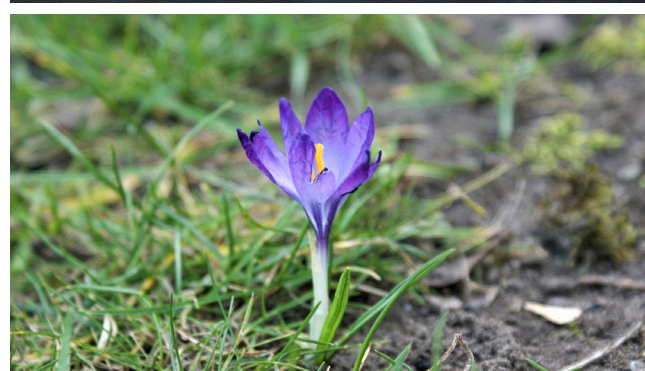
BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION
