GM Klang Wholesale City seeks to house wholesalers under one roof

IN 2007, the GM Kuala Lumpur - a wholesale business complex formerly known as Plaza GM - was listed in the Malaysia Book of Records as the largest wholesale centre. With the experience and growth of GM Kuala Lumpur and its ability to provide the demands for wholesale business, the developers have decided to set a greater goal: building the largest wholesale sales in Southeast Asia outside Kuala Lumpur, the Klang.

GM Klang Wholesale City is a wholesale business complex in Bandar Botanik, south of Klang. Developed and managed by Gamuda GM Klang Sdn Bhd and intentionally designed to facilitate an optimum wholesale environment, its proximity to Malaysia's largest port, Port Klang, the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) and Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport makes it an ideal location as a major hub and gateway for regional and international trade business.

Established in 2009, GM Klang Wholesale City has become a go-to place in Malaysia for those sourcing wholesale products. The complex offers a wide array of products including home decorations, wedding decorations, fashion apparel, electronic goods, IT products, textile, souvenirs and handicrafts.

Currently GM Klang Wholesale City has two blocks in operation - Block 'A' and 'C'. Block 'B' is still under construction and expected to be open in the fourth quarter

of this year. With the completion of Block 'B', the complex will have the capacity to accommodate up to 2,500 wholesale shops.

The ten-storey tall Block 'A' has five levels, accommodating more than 900 wholesale shops. Each level has been segmented by product category, such as children's apparel, educational materials, leather goods, electronics, gadgets, beauty care and home décor.

In Block 'A', Level 5 is an international zone, housing foreign wholesalers who market their products without the need to travel far for product sourcing.

Block 'C' houses wholesalers specialised in home decorations such as beddings, hardware, curtains and carpets, car accessories and wedding accessories.

Block 'B' will be the fashion hub of GM Klang Wholesale City and will house a wide selection of fashion products under one roof to become the platform for wholesalers to reach customers with creativity and fashion trends.

GM Klang Wholesale City is also a platform for younger generations to immerse themselves in business to encourage venturing into wholesale, retail and industry.

"The idea of forming or setting up this wholesale city is something new in Malaysia and it is our idea of putting all the wholesalers under one roof," said Dato' Lim Seng Kok, Gamuda GM Klang Sdn Bhd Managing Director. "We are trying to achieve a multi-lateral trading platform for

the creation of the one-stop comprehensive wholesale city for Southeast Asia."

Dato' Lim Seng Kok added that he hopes to see young entrepreneurs from Brunei, Sabah and Sarawak to come and set up wholesale shops and market their products.

Gamuda GM Klang Sdn Bhd will also have

a new building soon, the GM Bukit Bintang Wholesale City, located in the heart of Kuala Lumpur's Golden Triangle. The business complex, now nearing completion, will be a high-end fashion wholesale centre as well as an ideal platform for local fashion designers to market their own brand and break into the global market.
