### UTASS Training Update NPTC Spraying qualifications

Spray training and assessments were held at Middleton Mart at the end of August/beginning of September for the NPTC Level 2 Award in the Safe Use of Pesticides ("PA" route for those born after 31.12.64) and Level 2 Award in the Safe Use of Pesticides replacing Grandfathers' Rights ("Unit" route). Gaining a qualification requires one day's training for each of the theory and practical elements, with "PA" Theory assessments only at the end of the training session and all other assessments the following week.

More training and assessments are planned for later this year or early next year, if there is sufficient demand, and approximate costs are:-

Level 2 Award (PA route preference or born post 31.12.64) theory + practical approx £187 + £90 + VAT training

Level 2 Award (Grandfather Rights) theory + practical (application of pesticides on own land only) approx. £165 + £90 + VAT for the training

Additional practical training costs approximately £104 registration & assessment + £60 + VAT for the training

#### NPTC Level 2 Award in the Transport of Animals by Road (Short Journeys)

Assessments for this qualification (no training required), were arranged for the same date as the NPTC PA1 Theory assessment. Cattle & Sheep are classed as one species and the assessment cost is £60 – additional assessments cost £35. For further details please see <u>www.nptc.org.uk</u> - Qualification handbook 600/0306/6 which states "This qualification is aimed specifically at people transporting animals over 65km and up to eight hours in duration, where the journey is in connection with an economic activity".

#### The Sir Tom Cowie Charitable Trust

Applications have been received for this round of funding for young people living in County Durham to learn driving skills, increase knowledge of health & safety, improve confidence and help achieve qualifications, in preparation for employment within the agricultural sector or to enable access to training and employment opportunities outside the area. Funding has been allocated for 10 trainees to attend the Lantra 13-16 Tractor Driving; 2 Trainees for Quad Bike Training; 5 Trainees for Car & Trailer and 4 Trainees for Car Lessons. There is still a place available for Pre-Test Tractor Driving & ATV training and application forms for this training for those aged 16 are available from Julia.

#### **Dales Health Network**

Funding was received for 10 young people to attend a Young Lifesaver Course held on 23<sup>rd</sup> May and an "Agricultural Vehicles Safety Awareness, including ATVs" will be held at Middleton Mart on 23<sup>rd</sup> October at 6.30pm. This is aimed at young people living on or visiting farms. Please let Jen Smurthwaite or Julia know if you would like to attend.

#### Heart of Teesdale

Funding from HLF funded Heart of Teesdale Landscape Partnership has provided free educational visits over 2 years to Middleton-in-Teesdale Auction Mart for 10 local schools, to include transport costs. The first school to visit was Bowes Hutchinson. This visit was also part funded by The Ernest Cook Trust who have funded Mart visits for around 400 children and by the Sir Tom Cowie Charitable Trust who funded a presentation by Graeme Gill from Deepdale Offroad to improve

knowledge of farm safety and in particular quad bikes. Four banners – Explore the Farming Year; Explore Farm Livestock; Explore Field Boundaries and Explore Teesdale's Harvest have also been funded as an educational resource and have been on display at Bowes, Eggleston & Langdon Beck Shows.

### **Minibus Training for Volunteers**

Applications have been received from Teesdale voluntary organisations to access Teesdale Action Partnership funding to train more volunteers to drive minibuses, whether D1 Test standard, Midas or non-accredited training. Six applicants are starting their D1 Test training (necessary to drive most minibuses if you passed your test after 1.1.97) and **more applications are welcome** - please see UTASS website for details.
