

BURITON ART & CRAFTS TRAIL 2019

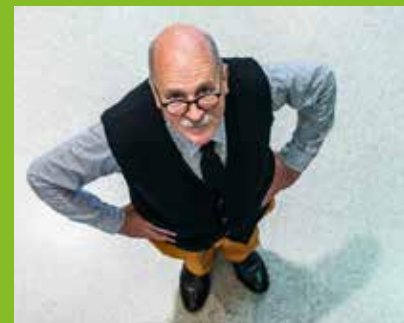
'Taster' evening – Friday 28 June
