

FRAMELESS SHOWER SCREENS – IMPORTANT INFORMATION

We are a dedicated manufacturer whose sole business activity is the design, development and production of an inspiring collection of showering products.

We produce frameless shower screens; we do not produce aquariums! If you require a 100% waterproof enclosure, especially when using power showers and body jets, you may want to consider choosing a traditional fully framed enclosure with large, obtrusive aluminum profiles.

An important feature of the design of our system is our hinges. They do not have gaps in them through which water will escape during normal showering. A benefit of their design is that the hinge allows for a full height translucent water seal to pass through the hinge, which further improve the water retaining performance.

It is unrealistic to expect any frameless shower screen to contain water if it is not used for the purpose for which it is intended, i.e. showering using either a fixed or adjustable showerhead. If you want to make a shower screen leak by forcing water at the seals, it will leak! The answer is not to try to make it leak but to use it for its intended purpose.

When planning the design of your shower, water retention is a key consideration and consideration must be given to the following;

- The position of your showerhead – to avoid the chance of water escaping, where possible, try not to have water aimed directly at the frameless shower screen.
- Install your frameless shower screen in a well ventilated area as steam may result in a build-up of mineral deposits.
- Walk-in frameless shower screens with no doors may allow water spray to pass beyond the length of the screen, dependent upon the position of the showerhead and the volume of water it delivers.
- As spray/mist may escape from your frameless shower screen, it is advisable to have a suitable waterproof floor outside the showering area.
