Station One Completed

Station One has recently been completed including all passenger facilities such as the elevators, turnstiles, platform screen doors, information displays and waiting areas. Station Two is not far behind.

Meanwhile inside the maintenance building, the control room is also fully functional and all vehicle lifts, garaging facilities and maintenance bays are installed within the depot facility below.

In a matter of only a few weeks, the first passenger vehicles will be rolling out across the Suncheon landscape in time for the opening of the International

Garden Expo in April.

Track Commissioning

With all 5km of double track fully implemented along the guideway, including the substation (which powers the third rail) and the CBTC communication network, track interface testing is now well under way using a specialised vehicle.
