Fostering curiosity - developing understanding

Having seen the recent communication regarding SOLOMON, a number have asked how do you enter the programme and navigate the system? To help you, here is a quick start guide:

Enter the following web address into your browser <https://Solomon.ugle.org.uk>

1. On the first page you see, click the PLAY button on the REGISTER YOUR ACCOUNT ON THE SYSTEM panel. You can follow the video (make sure your sound is on) and follow the directions or simply:
2. Click on LOG-IN)the large red arrow points to this
3. On the next page click on CREATE NEW ACCOUNT
4. To set up your account complete the details on this page
5. Having done so, look for the email which will be sent to you, keeping the SOLOMON page open in your browser
6. Once you receive the email, open and click on the long URL to authenticate who you are. If you do not receive an email check your junk / spam folder, it may be in there, if so move it to your safe senders list and continue
7. The next page will show your name and confirm that you have registered
8. Click on CONTINUE – that's it, all done!

You are now on the front page after log-in and here you can select the category to enter. Each category works in much the same way but to enable you to gain a feel for the system:

- Click on the SEEK & LEARN panel; you can then decide which module to look into
- Click on the selected panel, or *enter*
- To ensure full use of the system, click on ENROL ME; you can now read the required documents or PowerPoint
- When you leave a document, you will see that a 'tick' appears to the right of the document, this simply acts a reminder that you have entered that particular paper or PowerPoint.
