
Offering practical support, friendship and advocacy in the local community, through volunteers.

## What's it about?

The Karis Be Friends project is about supporting vulnerable and isolated older people in our community.

Some older people find themselves living alone, without friends or family nearby to offer company and support, and struggle to get out on their own.

We try to see that people who are lonely or housebound are visited regularly, have someone to talk to and can get a helping hand when they need it, as well as having opportunity to get out and about every so often.



The main thing we offer is someone to visit you regularly in your home.

This may be to sit and chat over a cup of tea or to share a hobby or interest.

If you struggle to get out and need a helping hand someone may be able to go out with you for a walk, help you get to the shops or go with you to an appointment.

Alongside home visiting we arrange regular social events from Sunday afternoon teas to Christmas parties.

If you need a practical task doing we may also be able to help. We can do little DIY jobs like putting up shelves or moving furniture around your home.

We can also help with gardening and some decorating if you can't manage to get it done yourself.
