



A message from **Chris Austin Exeter Director**

Exeter City Council Kitchens— Works have dropped this year on a temporary basis, due to cut backs and money needed for other projects. Kitchens and bathrooms will run at 2 per week after April with a contract value of £1 million.

Exeter City Council Electrical Remedial Works—works involved carrying out ECR, then return and upgrade all cat 1 & 2; this is still ongoing but will end very soon and this contract is valued at £120,000

Exeter City Council Fire Doors— are still ongoing with the works involved including the removal of the flat entrance door and fitting a new half hour fire rated brit door; we fit about 20 per week with a contract value of £250,000

Exeter City Council Water Ingress— is due to end over the next 6 weeks, works involved included the removal of the old cavity wall insulation, re-fill wall insulation with new insulation, treat external brick work with a waterproof clear coating, rake out and repoint brick works. Contract value of £200,000

Royal Masonic Benevolent Institution Codington Court—contract will be complete by end of July; these are a new client to Jones with works involved including the refurbishment bedrooms, wet rooms, kitchens and a reception area as well as renewing all timber decking to external areas, contract value of at £250,000

NPS, Agents for Devon City Council: 3 Schools—Project has just been complete after all three schools had new roof coverings - contract value of £200,000

Exeter City Council: Beacon lane Boundary wall—Included demolishing the old wall which was falling down, new foundations, a new wall, removing the slabbed paving stones and laying new tarmac. The contract has just been completed and has a contract value of £80,000

East Devon District Council: Summersby Close— Involved making use of the outhouse and extending it to the kitchen for venerable tenant, removing the bathroom and replacing it with a wet room. This is due to be completed at the end of June, contract value— £33,000
