Synopsis: Tony Award-winner Elizabeth Ashley is the legendary Ann Richards in ANN, a no-holds-barred look at the brassy, blue governor who changed the face of Texas politics. Directed by Drama Desk Award-winner Michael Wilson, enjoy the story of an impassioned woman who enriched the lives of others with all the charm, charisma, and persuasion that makes a politician good at her job.

LANGUAGE: The language of the show is reflective of Ann Richards herself, and she does use occasional adult language, particularly in reminding people that she is, indeed, "the fucking Governor of Texas." (Also included are 'damn,' 'ass,' and one reference to a 'circle jerk.')

SMOKING/DRINKING: Alcohol and alcoholism are discussed at length in the show, but no drinking occurs onstage.

SEX: There is no overtly suggestive or indulgent content in the show.

VIOLENCE: There is no on-stage violence.

FOR WHICH AUDIENCES? Recommended for high-school audiences and up.

RATING: If Ann were a film, it would most likely be rated PG-13 for language and adult themes.
