Curriculum and Standards – terms of reference 2021-22

Membership:

- 1. The membership will consist of no fewer than 4 governors.
- 2. The committee may have additional members as required.
- 3. Minutes will be taken by the Company Secretary or a nominated person in her absence.

The committee can only function if there are a minimum of 3 governors present at the meeting (Quorum), at least two of which must be non-staff members. The committee shall not meet without the Headteacher being present or someone nominated by him or her.

The committee will meet at least 5 times a year. It can agree to meet more frequently if necessary.

Terms of reference:

- 1. Gain an understanding and overview of all curriculum areas and their place within the broader school curriculum.
- 2. To advise the full governing body on the school's curriculum and its statutory obligations.
- 3. To review the curriculum of the school in accordance with the national and local requirements.
- 4. To oversee the governing body's curriculum responsibilities within the school, to review curriculum policies including sex education, collective worship and SEND.
- 5. To be informed of the appointment of subject co-ordinators and any changes in curriculum responsibilities.
- 6. To hold the school to account regarding inspection reports, have oversight of action plans and monitor progress, including the allocation of Pupil Premium funding.
- 7. To receive regular reports on the progress being made towards achieving school improvement and student progress targets.
- 8. To make recommendations on strategic priorities and ensure that targets are set to improve student achievement and school innovation.
- 9. To review information about school performance and its reports to parents.
- 10. To contribute to the school's improvement plan.
- 11. To receive reports and monitor the quality assurance of teaching and learning.
- 12. To have oversight of vision and policy for teaching & learning, curriculum, CPD, SIP and the relationship between these areas.
