Internship at PWAMM is a great way to invest a year of your life exploring your vocation, growing as a leader and as a disciple of Jesus Christ. What difference could you make to our ministry and what difference could it make in your life?

`Go ye, therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit; teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the world.' (Matthew 28:19-20)

Every aspect of our ministry is unashamedly mission focused; we are seriously committed to sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We offer a number of areas for your internship; you will be based in one of our working departments, according to where you believe your gifts and skills are most appropriate and you will also have the opportunity to be part of our frontline mission and ministry teams, taking the Gospel of Jesus out to the communities of Scotland, reaching from the Borders to the Highlands and Islands.

Challenger Buses take the Good News of the Gospel around the nation with onboard cinema and separate coffee lounge; the Community bus team are operational in Perth City Centre on a Friday and Saturday evening; every month we run Pastors and Leaders Prayer Luncheons in Perth, Glasgow and Inverness, each attended by up to 50 Christian leaders; Gospel Tent Missions are held in different communities around Scotland using our own 250 seater marquee; our own theatre group performs sketches and full length drama productions; the Upper Room Choir take the Gospel out to the nation in song; ACTS discipleship course has attracted students from around the world and Puppets with a Mission children's ministry teaches the Gospel using modern tunes with Christian lyrics.

Challenger Education teaches the foundations of the Christian faith in schools under the Curriculum for Excellence. We have visited over 200 schools over the past 10 years with up to 70 visits now recorded each year.

Our Community Care Programme reaches many people especially those who are most at risk from loneliness and isolation; offering to senior citizens free lunch events twice monthly; a weekly Bible fellowship; Monday church; church services in 10 nursing homes and sheltered housing complexes around Perthshire; Christmas Appeal with over 1400 gift bags distributed each year; The Well provides essential services to people with addiction issues and those in refuge and Joseph's Storehouse provides food and help for those in need all year round.



You will have the opportunity to choose one or two focused areas of ministry and you will be working alongside the particular leaders in those areas. This will allow you to develop in that particular ministry and in leadership.

Throughout the year there will also be specialised training; a dedicated weekly Bible teaching day; practical experience, and opportunities to be out `on the road'. You will be working hard, be challenged and inspired, but it will be hugely rewarding and beneficial to you as you develop spiritually and in leadership.

WHO?

The internship at PWAMM is a voluntary year tailored for anyone aged 18+ who has a passion to encounter the love of God, grow in their relationship with Him, explore how the church can impact the local community and be equipped and empowered to impact their world with the good news of lesus Christ.

DURATION

An internship at PWAMM could commence at any time and we can be flexible on duration. However, we ask that you give consideration to commitment for a year in order that you can benefit from the experience of a full programme at PWAMM. Interns are required to serve a core 40 hours per week; however, there are occasions when we give additional time in our commitment to serve the Lord as part of our calling.

During the year interns will be entitled to 15 days holiday which must be taken in agreement with departmental leaders in order that missional and outreach commitments and peak times at the National Christian Outreach Centre can be staffed.

PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

Accommodation will be provided for interns and a subsistence allowance will be provided for the duration of the internship. What you will get out of this internship will be hugely rewarding; you will gain invaluable life skills, be able to work in a structured ministry environment and gain ministry experience. In addition, our working departments in Administration, Graphics & Media, IT, Vehicle & Building Maintenance, Conference & Catering all offer valuable training and experience for the future.
