Further information

Winter uniform is worn for the Autumn and Spring Term/Summer uniform is worn for the Summer Term.

All children must keep their uniforms neat and tidy, and every single garment that is not embroidered that are worn to school from blazers to socks (and including footwear) must be clearly marked with your child's name.

From Reception to Year 2 a Bronte School book bag is available from the school office (you will be invoiced for this). From Year 3 to Year 6 children are to have a **large** (15") brown leather satchel (available from The Sewing Shop) and have a pencil case with pencils, eraser, pencil sharpener, coloured pencils, whiteboard pen and glue stick.

Girls should have long hair tied back using Bronte School scrunches or hairbands (school colours purchased from The Sewing Shop). Boys are expected to have a conventional hairstyle (eg. no designer stripes). If girls have beads in their hair for religious reasons, it is expected that they are in school colours (blue and white for the Winter and Spring Term and yellow and white for the Summer Term).

NO jewellery may be worn except a watch and plain, gold or silver, ear studs for reasons of safety. **No sparkles pearls or diamonds please!** NO EARRINGS PLEASE ON RECEPTION CLASS BUSY DAYS. Ear studs must be removed for P.E. and games from Year 3 – 6, and the child is responsible for doing this. **If your child is unable to remove their own earrings, please ensure they do not wear them to school on days that sport or swimming lessons take place.** Boys are not permitted to wear earrings. School coloured sweatbands may be worn during PE to enclose religious bangles for safety reasons.

It would be appreciated if children could be taught to tie their own shoelaces and ties as soon as possible. Lower school children should **NOT** wear footwear with laces – velcro only please.

EVERYTHING MUST BE ORDERED FROM THE SCHOOL UNIFORM SHOP, PREFERABLY AT LEAST HALF A TERM IN ADVANCE.

Items can be ordered and delivered to the school. Any lost or unnamed items will be stored in lost property until the end of term and if unclaimed will be disposed of.
