## Bottoms Up Beer Run

SAAZ's 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Bottoms Up Beer Run is taking place on **June 8<sup>th</sup>** and we need YOU to be part of it! The club has donated \$25,000 to St. Baldrick's Foundation for pediatric cancer research so far through this event and we would like this year to be even bigger and better.

How you can help:

- Help promote the event Share the event page on Facebook and encourage all your running/walking/strolling friends to participate. Talk up the fun aspects of the event and remind them that costumes, groups, and furry four-legged friends are welcome to participate (and that beer is involved). Remind them that the proceeds help support a very worthwhile charity as well as SAAZ. Get some promotional materials from event director Anne Gregg and spread the word around your town with posters and postcards. It's a great way for newer runners/walkers to get their feet wet with racing since it's a 4K rather than a 5K, and so it's a bit shorter than many of the area races.
- Work the event <u>Email Anne</u> and volunteer to work the race. We need help to set up, get runners/walkers checked in, to pour/distribute beer, to work the raffle, to help distribute snacks, etc.
- Help find sponsors Encourage friends with businesses to become a BUBR sponsor.
   They'll get some great promotional exposure, the event will be even bigger and better thanks to their generosity, and we'll be able to donate even more to St. Baldrick's Foundation. Again, email Anne if you have any leads on possible sponsors or if your business or employer would like to become a sponsor.



## About that Facebook thing...

As most of you probably know, SAAZ has a presence on Facebook, which we find very helpful to disseminate information quickly (especially when a last-minute event/opportunity arises) and to help promote the club. Here are a few tips so you can get the most out of our Facebook pages.

#### WHY YOU WANT TO BE PART OF THE SAAZ FACEBOOK SCENE

- It's a quick and easy way for us to disseminate news and information quickly between newsletter
  mailings. When "breaking news" happens such as a last-minute invitation to pour our beers at a fest, a
  spontaneous decision to gather the group for a beer or two, a request from a sponsor to help with an
  event, or an unexpected change to a planned activity, we can have the info out on Facebook in mere
  moments.
- Our officers and members also post educational articles about brewing, photos of their brew days and SAAZ events/activities, information about local beer/brew-related events, and some funny stuff.

#### WHAT IF I DON'T WANT ALL THAT FACEBOOK DRAMA?

- You don't have to be active elsewhere on Facebook to take advantage of the stuff we post on our public page or in our group. If you're "Facebook shy" or don't want to deal with all the craziness out there, just create a profile and be a lurker or a participant on ONLY the SAAZ pages (some people don't even use their real name). You don't need to accept any Facebook "friend invitations" if you don't want to. Once you've created your account, go to the SAAZ Homebrew Club page and "Like" it, and then "Follow" it to help ensure you see our posts.
- If you're a paid SAAZ member, you should also go to the **SAAZ Members** group and ask to "Join." Once a moderator adds you to the group, set your "Notifications" for the group to "All Posts."

#### WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE TWO SAAZ FACEBOOK PAGES?


- SAAZ has two primary Facebook thingies... SAAZ Homebrew Club and SAAZ Members.
- SAAZ Homebrew Club is a public page that anyone can "Like" and "Follow."
- **SAAZ Members** is a <u>closed group</u> for paid members only. This members-only group hasn't been purged for a while, but we're about to do that so it matches our current membership list. If you're a paid member of the club and your Facebook account uses a fake name or former name that's different from what we'd have for your SAAZ membership, email <a href="editor@saaz.org">editor@saaz.org</a> and let Laurie know so we don't accidentally purge you.
- SAAZ meetings and other public activities, events and announcements are posted on our public page, **SAAZ Homebrew Club**.
- SAAZ parties, activities/meetings held at member residences, and any members-only offers and activities are posted in the **SAAZ Members** group. This is also where we share questions and tips, fun beer/brew related articles, links to local beer/brew related events, etc.

#### I'VE JOINED, FOLLOWED, AND ALL THAT, BUT STILL SEEM TO MISS SOME SAAZ POSTS

Even if you have "follow" and "notifications" set, remember that Facebook is going to feed you new posts from these two pages mixed in with the stuff from your Facebook friends and all the other pages, groups and events you're following, as well as some ads (ugh!). That means SAAZ stuff may get buried or may scroll by without you seeing it. Here are some tips to help you catch all the SAAZ news:


- Prioritize the SAAZ Homebrew Club page in your Facebook news feed.
  - On your Facebook homepage, click the drop-down arrow on the top right and select "News Feed Preferences".
  - Select "Prioritize who to see first".
  - Choose "Pages only" in the view options. You can then select SAAZ Homebrew Club as a page you wish to see first in your newsfeed.





- Adjust your notifications (there are too many notification settings to mention here... you can set
  notifications to appear on your desktop, by email, by text message, etc.). Notification settings can
  be found under Settings (just below the News Feed Preferences) in the graphic above.
- If you're only on Facebook for the SAAZ stuff, treat it like reading your favorite section of the daily newspaper each day. Just go right to the SAAZ Homebrew Club page and the SAAZ Members group each day and see what's new by using the search field in Facebook. This works on both your computer and in the Facebook app on your smart phone.





- On your computer desktop, create shortcuts to take you right to the SAAZ Homebrew Club page and the SAAZ Members group (this works the smoothest if you leave yourself logged in to Facebook all the time).
  - 1. Right-click on your desktop.
  - Select New, then Shortcut.
  - 3. Enter <a href="https://www.facebook.com/saazhomebrew/">https://www.facebook.com/saazhomebrew/</a> for the location, then click **Next**.
  - 4. Enter SAAZ Homebrew Club for the shortcut name, then click Finish.
  - 5. Repeat steps 1-4, using <a href="https://www.facebook.com/groups/SAAZMembers/">https://www.facebook.com/groups/SAAZMembers/</a> for the location and SAAZ Members for the shortcut name.
