The innovative HOFMANN dual revenue tablet-driven automated test lane allows workshops to revolutionise their MOT testing and complete the entire test from the bay.

Technicians using the new lane will be able to utilise the handheld tablet to connect wirelessly to the new web-based DVSA system and it will also give them more flexibility when it comes to the individual aspects of the test.

For example, the tablet will be the driver for the brake and emissions tests, meaning the technician can immediately receive live readings and enter the results without having to leave the vehicle.

The pass/fail guidelines can also be accessed using the tablet, which requires workshops to have an on-site broadband connection in order to connect to the new DVSA system.

The lift comes with rear slip plates as standard, meaning it can be used for wheel alignment work when not in MOT operation – creating a better return on investment.

Also included as standard in a HOFMANN ATL are: unique wireless brake test with smooth grip rollers – the only rollers with a ten-year surface warranty; modular wireless emissions with industry-leading water control system; free wireless upgrade including tablet PC, emulation software, router and WiFi dongle (separate customer broadband connection required); unique cable and pulley alignment; hose and wire tidier; two-year warranty.
