SEMINAR DESCRIPTION: Three day intensive workshop on the use of selected hand tools, power tools, and equipment used in the art of Guitar Making. Each student will construct an electric guitar body from scratch using templates provided by the staff. This project will enable students to practice some of the most important woodworking skills used in guitar making, including: measuring, milling, joinery, squaring, sanding, assembly, and finishing.

COURSE OBJECTIVE: To give incoming students the opportunity to familiarize themselves with the R-V shop environment and tool use and maintenance. Especially recommended for students with little or no previous woodworking experience, and for those who wish to brush up on skills.

The hand tools, power tools, and milling tools to be covered in lecture and demonstration are listed below:
