In the UK many animal and plant species are protected by law and must be considered during the planning process. Surveys are required whenever there is potential for protected species to be present.

Botanical & Habitat Surveys

Some plant species and habitats are legally protected in the UK and must be considered by local planning authorities during the planning process.

Detailed botanical surveys are likely to be necessary, for example, where a Preliminary Ecological Appraisal has identified semi-natural habitats on site or it is proposed to remove a hedgerow as part of a development.

Our specialist botanists undertake a range of habitat and botanical surveys, including:
