



## **Dublin Array Offshore Wind Farm**



Dublin Array Offshore Wind Farm is the first offshore project in innogy's Ireland portfolio



Dublin Array is located on the Kish and Bray Banks, 10km from the coast of Dublin and Wicklow Counties.

## €1 billion

The capital investment is expected to be in excess of €1 billion



Dublin Array could consist of between 60-100 turbines up to 250 metres tall to the tip of the rotor blade



At its height, during construction Dublin Array could see thousands of people working on the project



Dublin Array could deliver 17% - 28% of the Government minimum target of 3.5GW of offshore electricity by 2030 as set out in the Climate Action Plan 2019.

## 50/50

Dublin Array is owned 50% by innogy and 50% by Saorgus Energy



innogy has a long history of supporting the communities in which it operates. As the project progress we will work with communities to develop our approach to supporting the local area, in line with the requirements of the Government's Renewable Energy Support Scheme.
