

PE and Sport Development Funding at Parkside School

The government is providing funding annually to support PE and Sports development in schools.

This funding is being jointly provided by the departments for education, health and culture, media and sport, and will see money going directly to primary school Head Teachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children.

The sport funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

The **2017/18 allocation** is estimated to be £8250 Under this initiative

- This year's expected money will be spent on upgrading the caged play area with specialist boarding to aid play for current ball games such as football and basketball.
- To expand the range of games that can be played in this area.

The **2016/17 allocation** was £8,240 under this initiative after initially expecting £3,427. Parkside put this initiative towards the following:

- Upgrading the large playground at the front of the school to provide an outdoor learning space for use throughout the day.
- The space provided both play equipment and also educational markings and boards to be used in lessons to support children's learning and enhance their outcomes.

Review of spending 2016/17

To refurbish the playground with new markings and a solid boat structure to encourage more children to develop a healthy active lifestyle through traditional playground games and fitness activities, which include multi-purpose goals, for example football and basketball.

To encourage well-being we have provided more resources to inspire imaginative play. All staff have had training around encouraging and monitoring a safe and thriving environment.

Specific staff undertook health and safety training to ensure good practice.
