FORTUNE 500 COMPANIES, 2019

Downtown is home to 10 of the 21 *Fortune 500* companies headquartered in Houston. The Houston metro area ranks fourth in the country behind New York (73), Chicago (34) and Dallas-Ft. Worth (24). In total, Downtown is home to 60 companies on the 2018 Fortune 500 List.

Seventy percent of downtown companies climbed in ranks from 2018 to 2019: *Enterprise Products Partners* moved from #105 (\$29.2 billion) to #89 (\$36.5 billion); *Plains GP Holdings, LP* moved from #115 (\$26.2 billion) to #94 (\$34.1 billion); *EOG Resources* moved from #270 (\$11.2 billion) to #181 (\$17.3 billion); *CenterPoint Energy* moved from #308 (\$9.6 billion) to #299 (\$10.6 billion); *Targa Resources* moved from #387 (\$8.8 billion) to #302 (\$10.5 billion); *Calpine* moved from #336 (\$8.8 billion) to #330 (\$9.5 billion); and *Cheniere* moved from #489 (\$5.6 billion) to #383 (\$8 billion). *Cheniere Energy*, *EOG Resources*, and *Targa Resources* made the largest leaps, climbing up 106, 89, and 85 levels, respectively. The *Fortune 500* companies headquartered Downtown and their rankings are listed below:
