# 01. How to install theme BOX

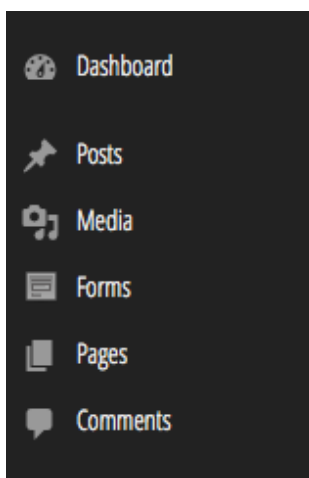
After purchasing theme BOX, your download contains a zip-file with the file name “BOX – unzip me please”.

## Installing theme BOX.

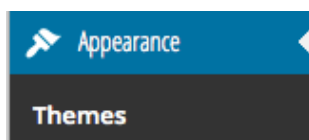
You can install BOX using several methods. We use the easiest and fastest approach though, and this is via your Wordpress dashboard.

1. Access your Wordpress account, and login.

Once you’ve logged in, you’ll be directed to the dashboard.



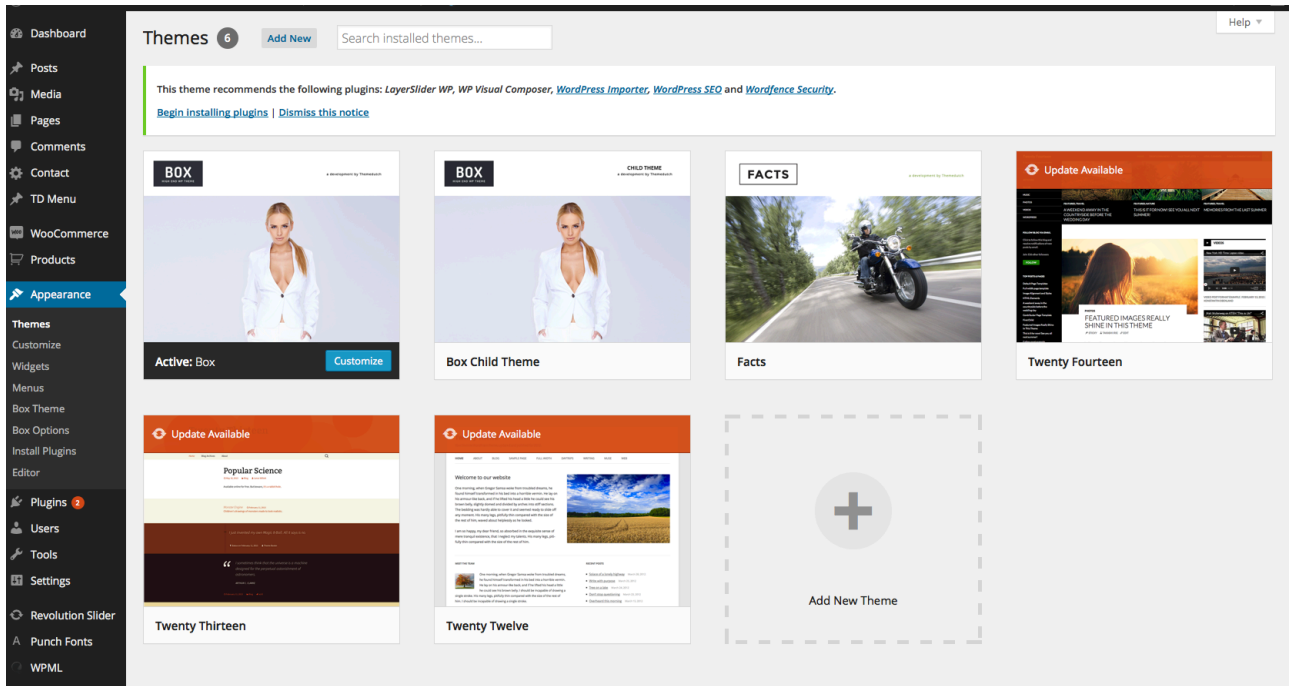
2. Go to **Appearance** and click **Themes**.



3. Click the **Add New** tab.
4. Next, hit **Upload**.
5. Still remember the BOX folder you unzipped earlier? Click the Browse button, locate the said BOX unzipped folder and then select it.
6. Click **Install Now**.
7. Wait for the installation to finish and then hit **Activate** link. Then you’ll see this screen.

## NOTE:

Theme BOX is now activated. Read the messages, which appear on your dashboard carefully, because they provide important info about “required and recommended plugins” for theme BOX. The Revolution Slider and The LayerSlider WP plugins are built-in, and only need to be activated.



## 02. How to install dummy content.

The **Tab Option Tools** is created for importing Dummy Content, and/or export your BOX theme options from file, text or URL.

### Import Dummy content.

Hit the button 'Install Dummy Content' if you would like to install the official BOX preview website's content.

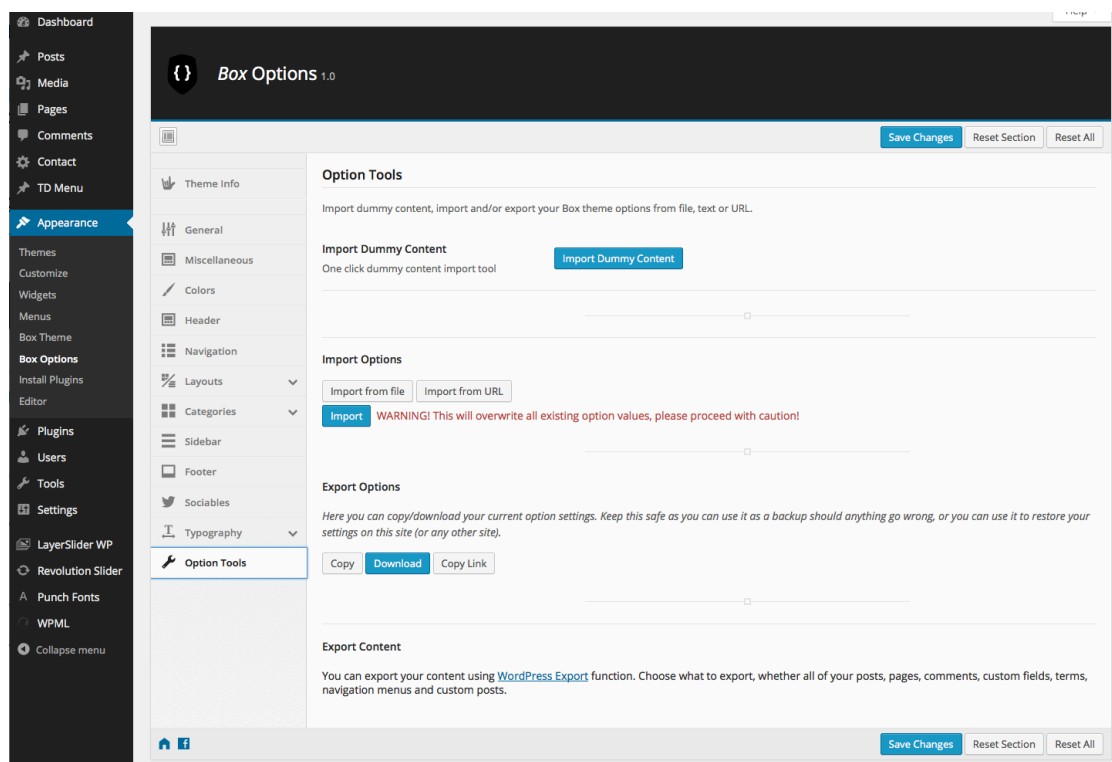
**NOTE: Importing dummy content 'may take a few minutes'. You're not able to install dummy content twice. If you want to install dummy content again, you'll have to reset this section first.**

**Installing dummy content will not cause problems if you have good quality hosting. In some cases the dummy content will not work, for example if you really have bad hosting.**

If installing dummy content worked ok, the button changes into green and says: dummy content already imported.

**Note: Sidebars and Widgets are not included in the dummy content. These you'll have to create yourself. You can read in the manual how to create Sidebars and Widgets.**

After installing Dummy content your page will look like this image below.

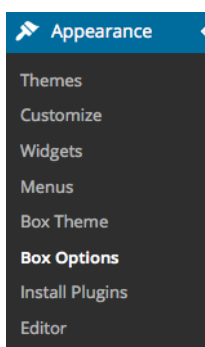
## 03. BOX Options – Theme Info

The BOX Option panel is one of BOX's most useful and powerful tools. Besides regular WP features, it contains almost all theme's controls, settings, options and functionalities.

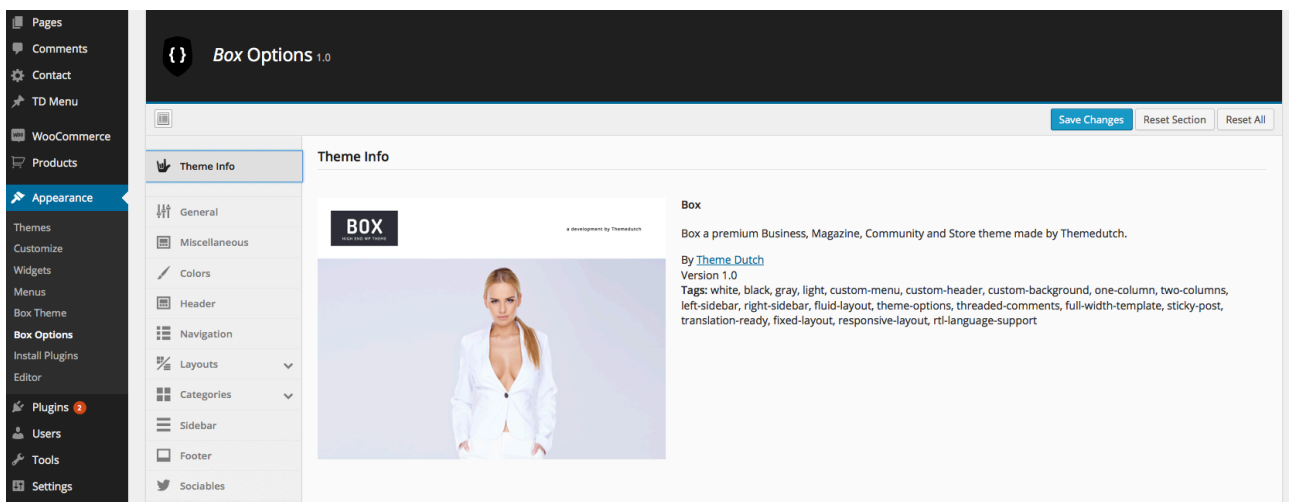
### TIP:

**if you're using theme BOX for the first time, we strongly advice to focus on the BOX Option Panel first. Learn all about its options and features.**

To access BOX's Option Panel, select **Appearance** menu and then select **BOX Options**.



BOX Option Panel contains 'settings for most theme features'. In here, you can change/set BOX Options: General, Miscellaneous, Colors, Header, Navigation, Layouts, Categories, Sidebars, Footer, Sociables, Typography Woocommerce and Option Tools.



**Note: Option Tools can be used for installing dummy content, importing and/or exporting your BOX Options from file, text or URL.**


## 04. BOX Options – General: general theme options

Let's start with the **General** theme options tab. In here you can upload your Favicon, Login Logo, and set your Page Background to none or including background image.

**Note: Your selected background image will be visible on all pages and posts, when the content background color is transparent, or when you choose a boxed layout.**

Here you also can choose displaying breadcrumbs and page titles. All settings are self-explanatory.

Don't forget to read/follow the additional suggestions and info, and hit the button '**Save changes**' when you're ready.

## 05. BOX Options – Miscellaneous

The next tab is **Miscellaneous**. On this tab you can turn on/off displaying the featured image on top of every post, including meta-information in your blog posts. In here you can enable/disable adding a page loader to the site. On the Miscellaneous tab you'll find also an option to enable or disable SEO Basic. **Note: read the SEO Basic warning.**

The **Miscellaneous** tab allows you add customized codes to your theme. You're able to place your custom css styles and custom javascripts via the tab Miscellaneous. In here you can place your snippet Google Analytics code as well, and it will be included in every page.



## 06. BOX Options – Colors: customize colors

In this Module, you can change / set the theme's colors. Here you can select your **Body background color**, and customize the colors for the theme's **Headings, Breadcrumbs, Content, Sidebar, and buttons**.

You can change the colors in two ways.

A. The first method is by manually inputting the HTML color codes to the provided boxes.

B. The second method is by hitting the box highlighted above, and dragging the color selector tool to your desired hue.

2. If you want your selected color to appear 'transparent' do like following: Use the slider on the right, and select the percentage (1-100%) of your chosen color. Then activate the button for transparency and hit Save Changes.

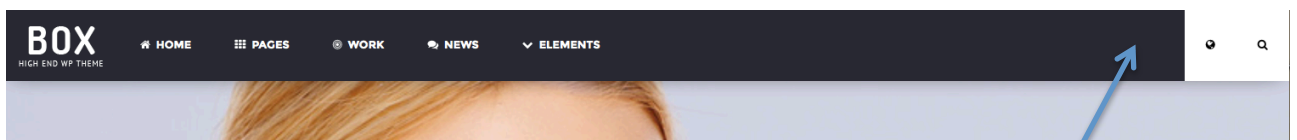
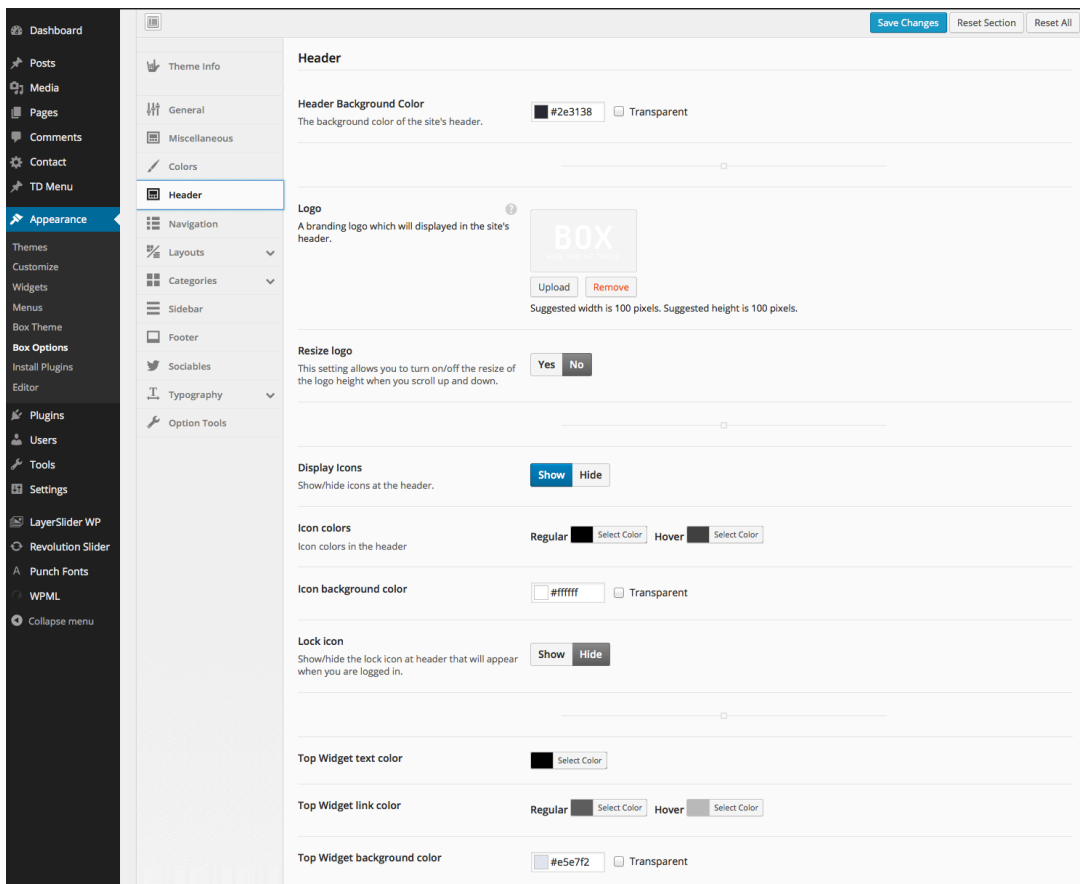

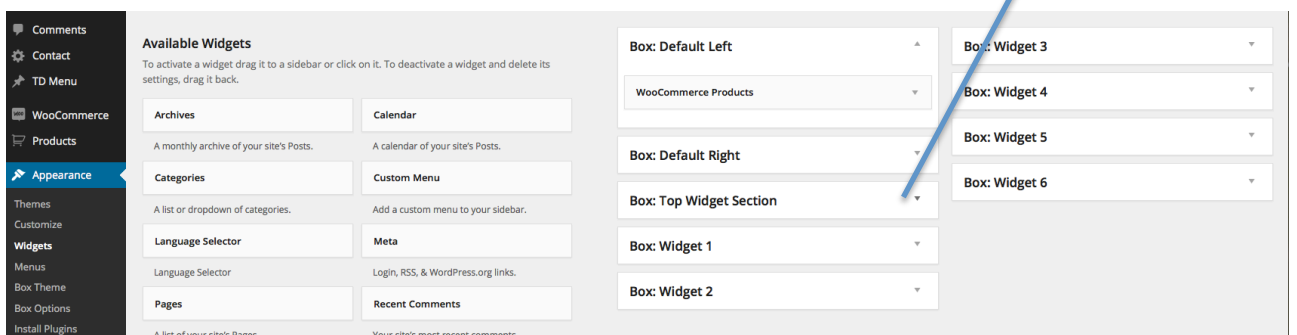
3. When you're done setting the colors, hit the **Save changes** button.

## 07. BOX Options – Header: customize header

This section allows customizing the theme’s header. All settings are self-explanatory.



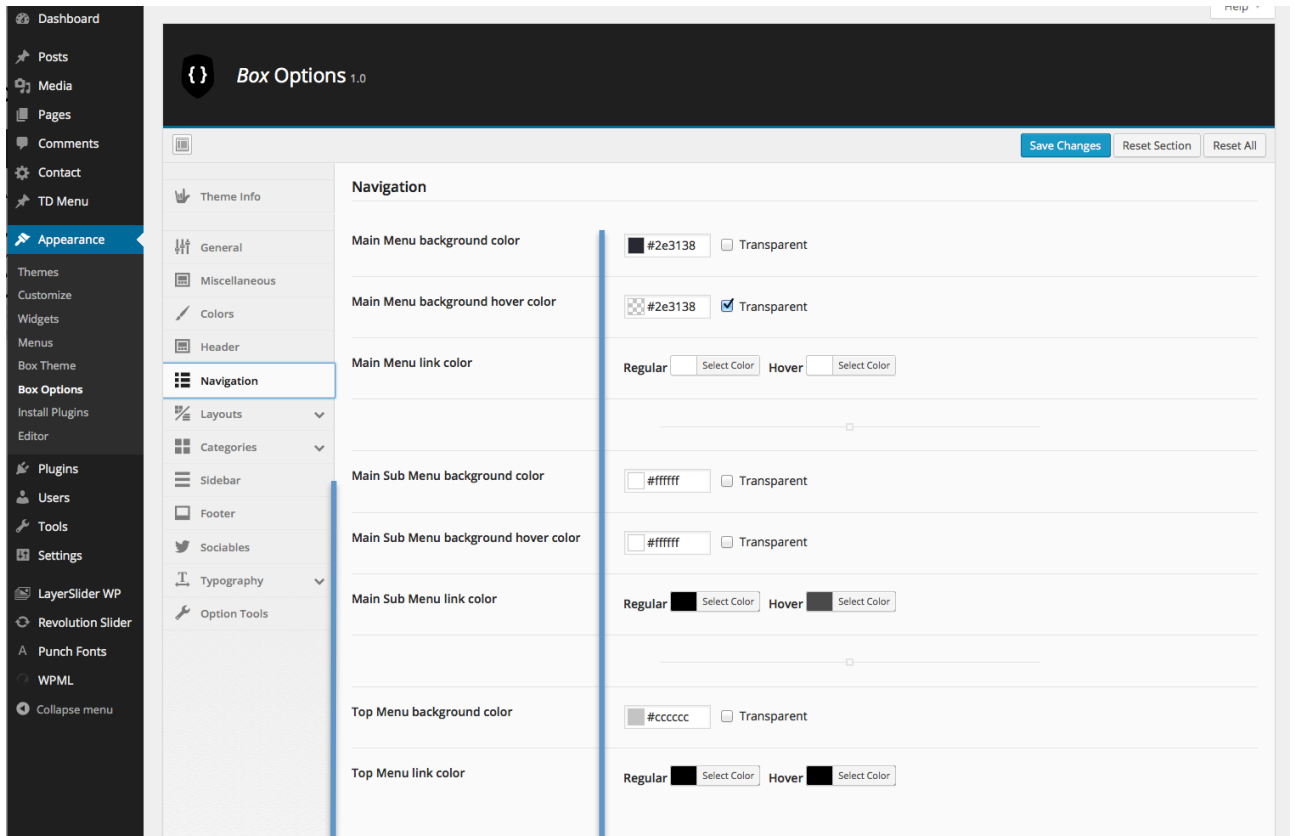
Note: In BOX we've set no 'top widget text' for the Top Widget section, which you can create via Appearance / Widgets.



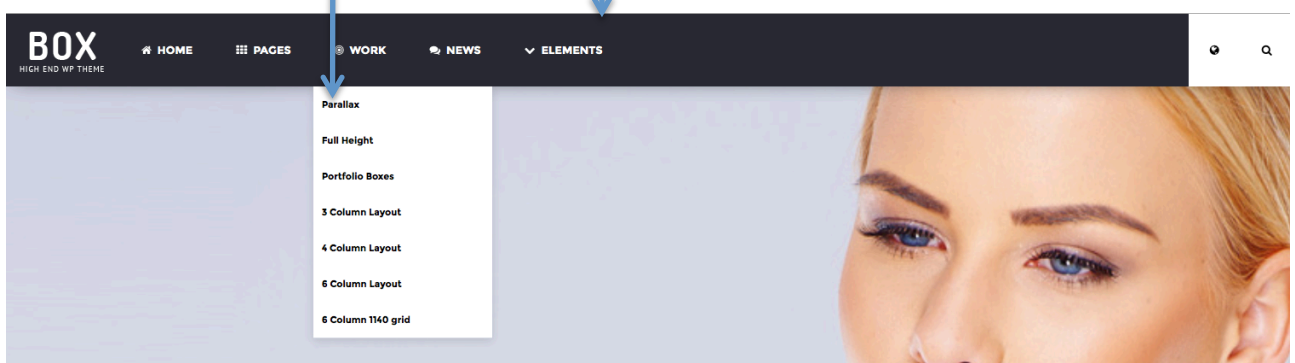
Note: When you choose your header background color to be transparent, your content header will start right at the top of your main menus. Otherwise it will start beneath your main menus.

## 08. BOX Options – Navigation: customize colors

This section allows customizing the theme's Main Menu, Main Sub Menu and Top Menu Colors. All settings are self-explanatory.

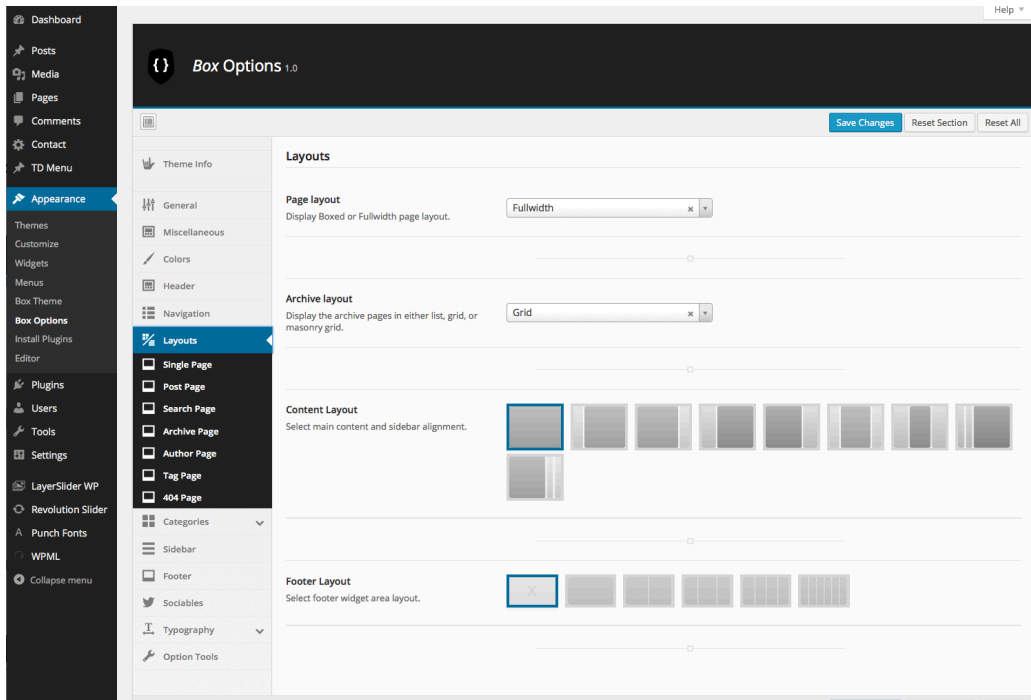


This is how it looks at the front-end of theme BOX.

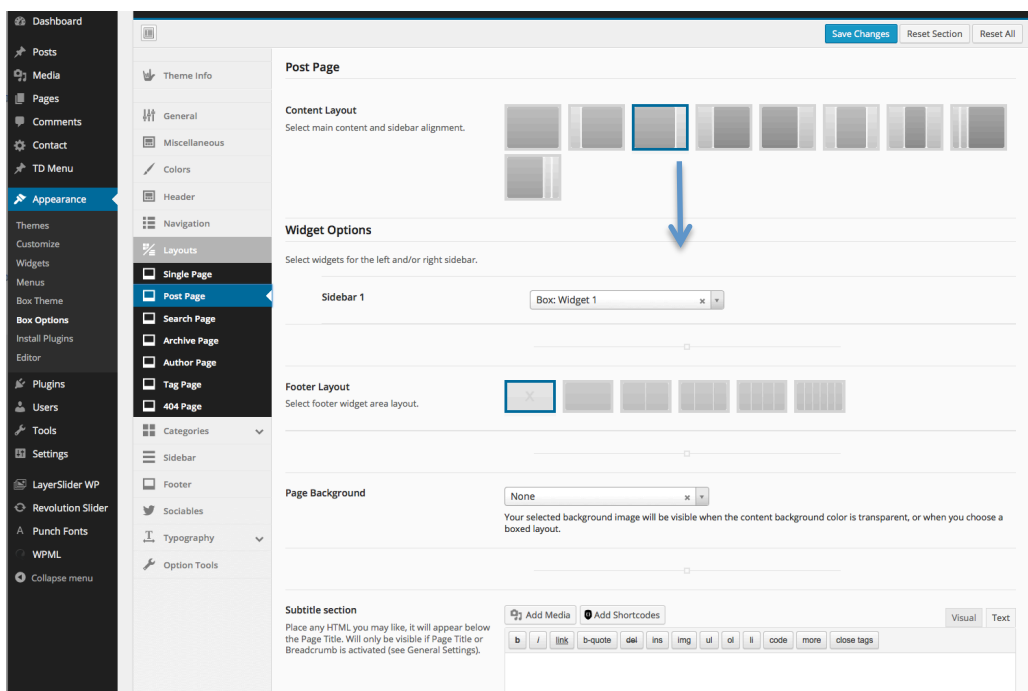


## 09. BOX Options – Layouts: for different pages

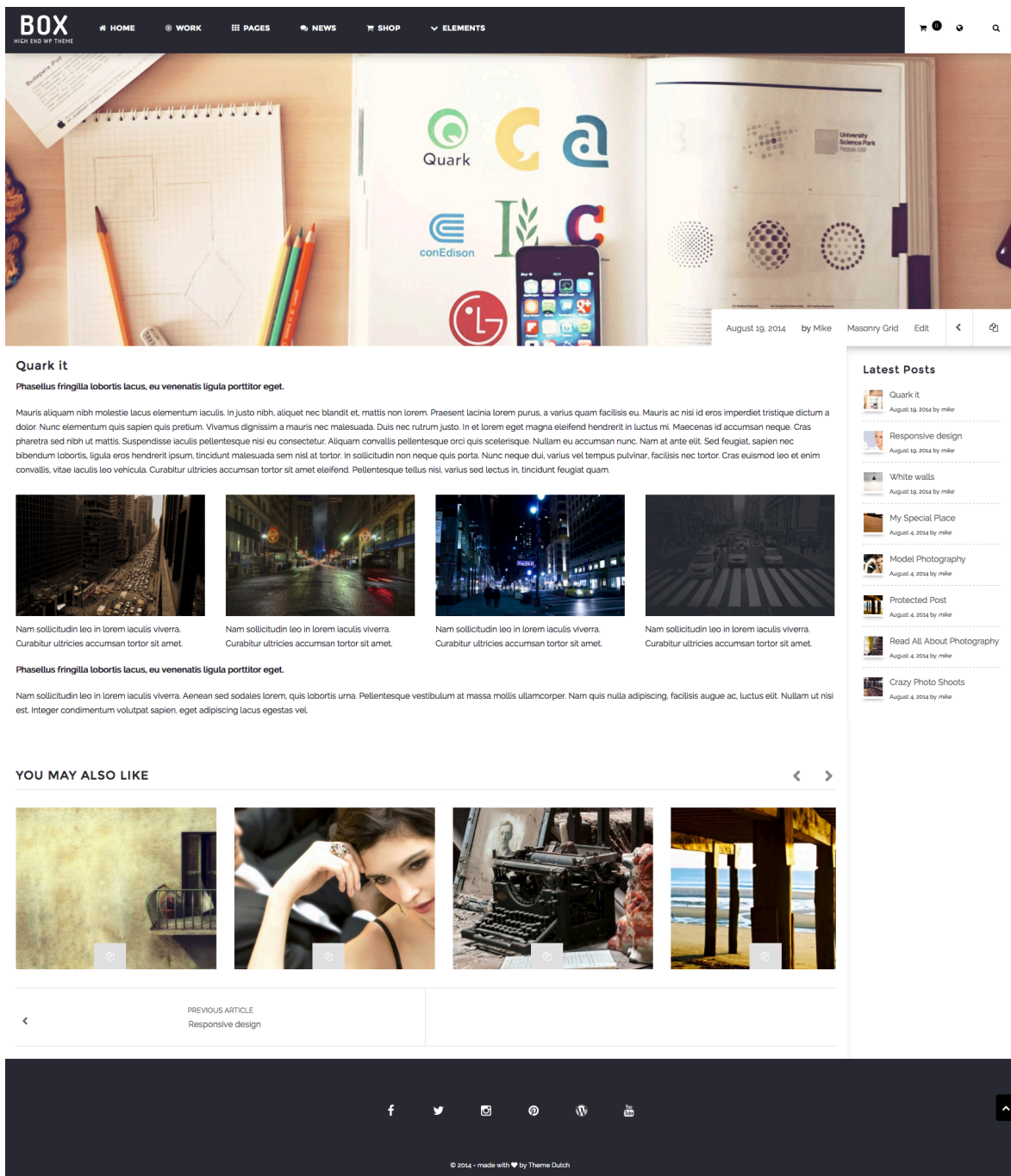
The BOX option ‘Layouts’ provides ultimate freedom in designing your page layouts. Here you’re able to set different layouts for default and separate pages, like: Single Page, Post Page, Search Page, Archive Page, Author Page, Tag Page and 404 Page. All settings are self-explanatory. Additional info is provided within the boxes.



Example Post page including sidebar right and no footer.

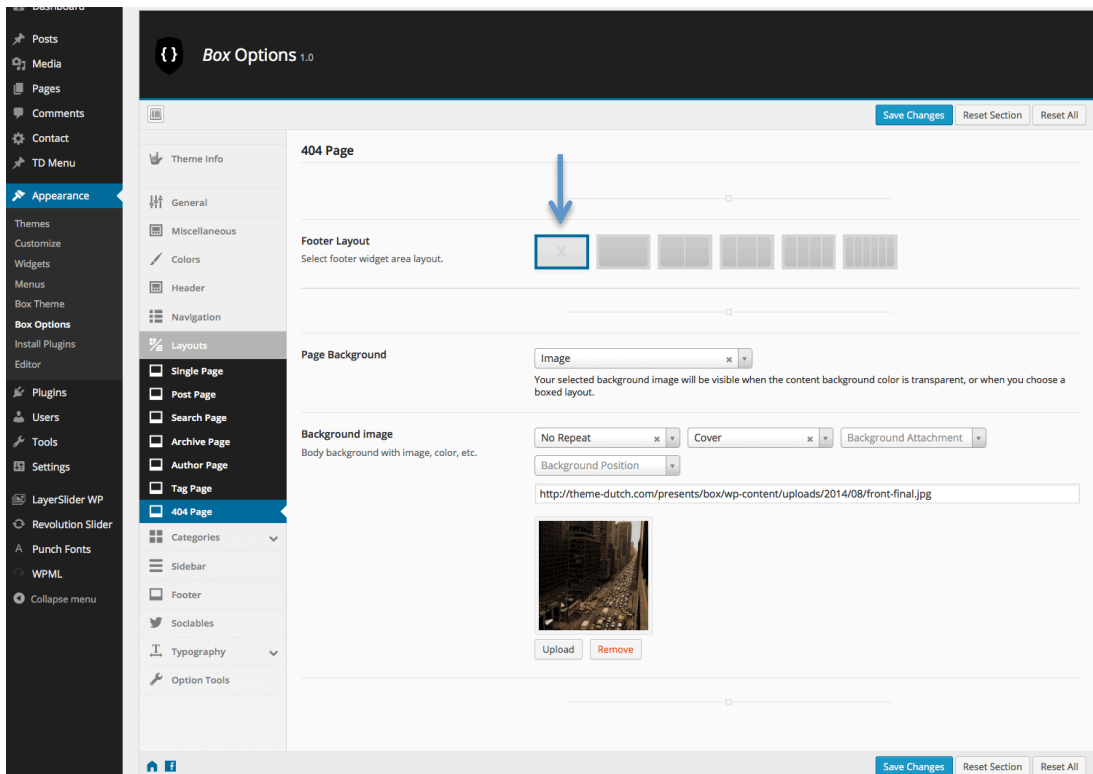


This is how a **BOX Post Page** looks at the front-end. We've selected a Sidebar Right including a Widget (Sidebar 1) and called it: "BOX: Widget 1". For post pages we've selected no footer layout and no page background.

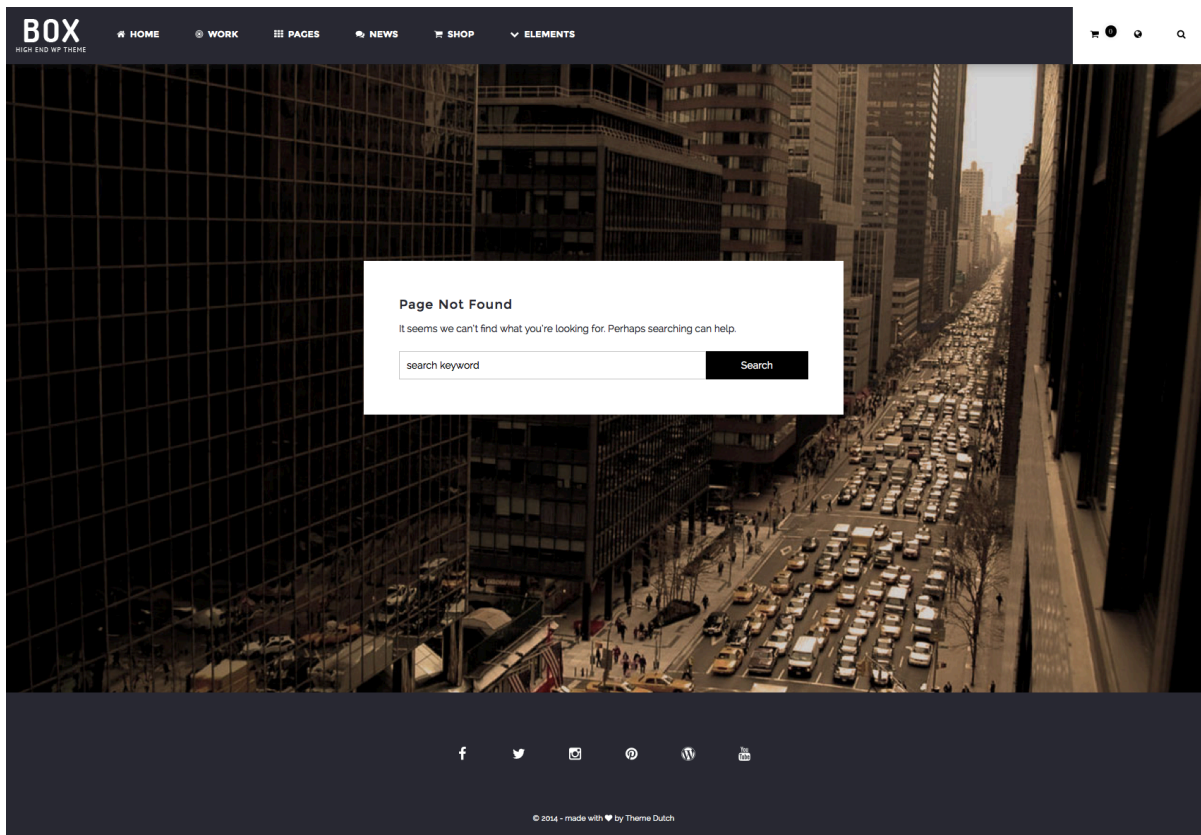


**NOTE: We'll discuss creating Sidebars and widgets for sidebars later on.**

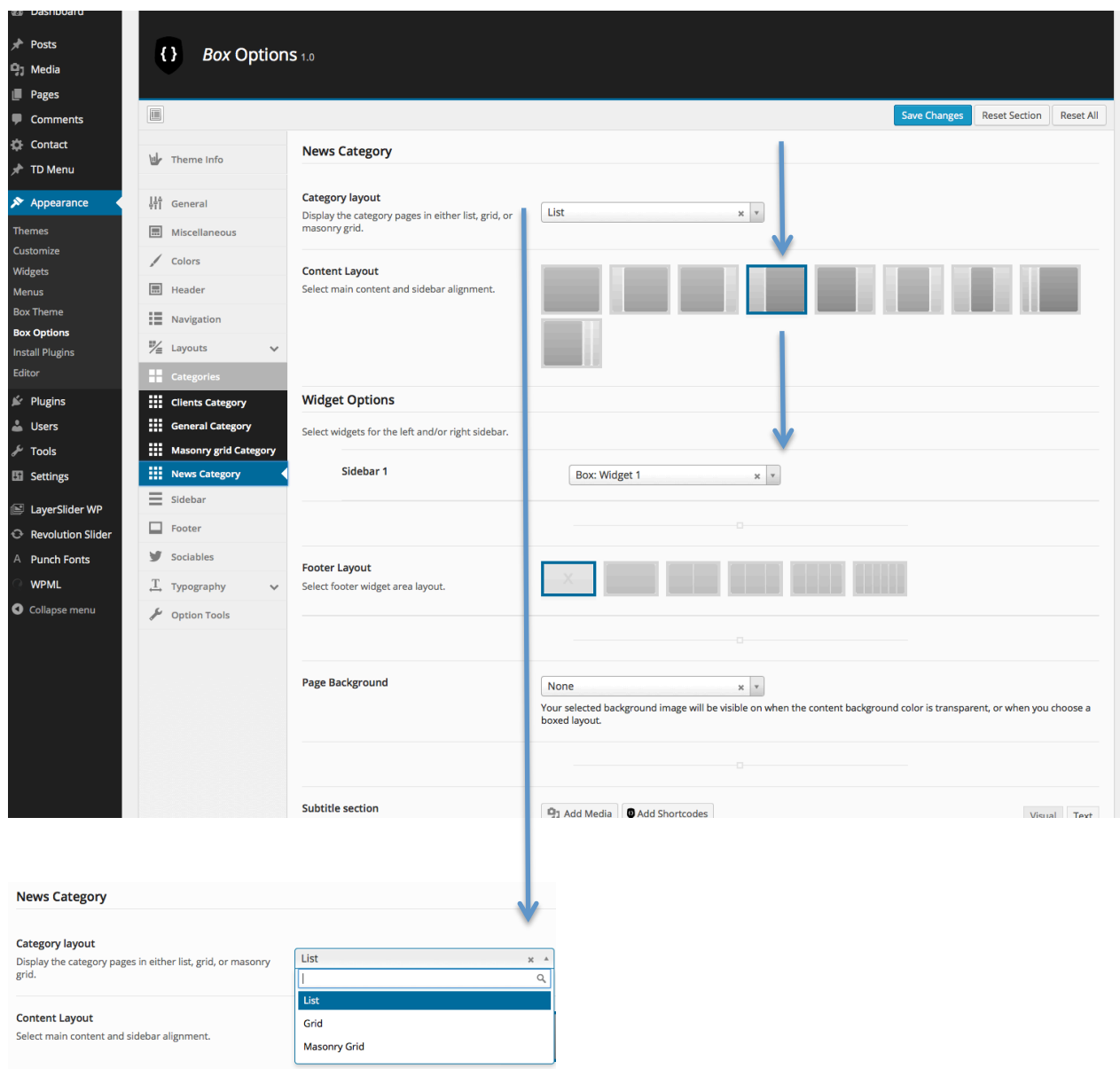


# 10. BOX Options – Categories: set/change layout for different blog categories

Here you're able to set different layouts for your Blog categories. All settings are self-explanatory. Additional info is provided within the boxes.

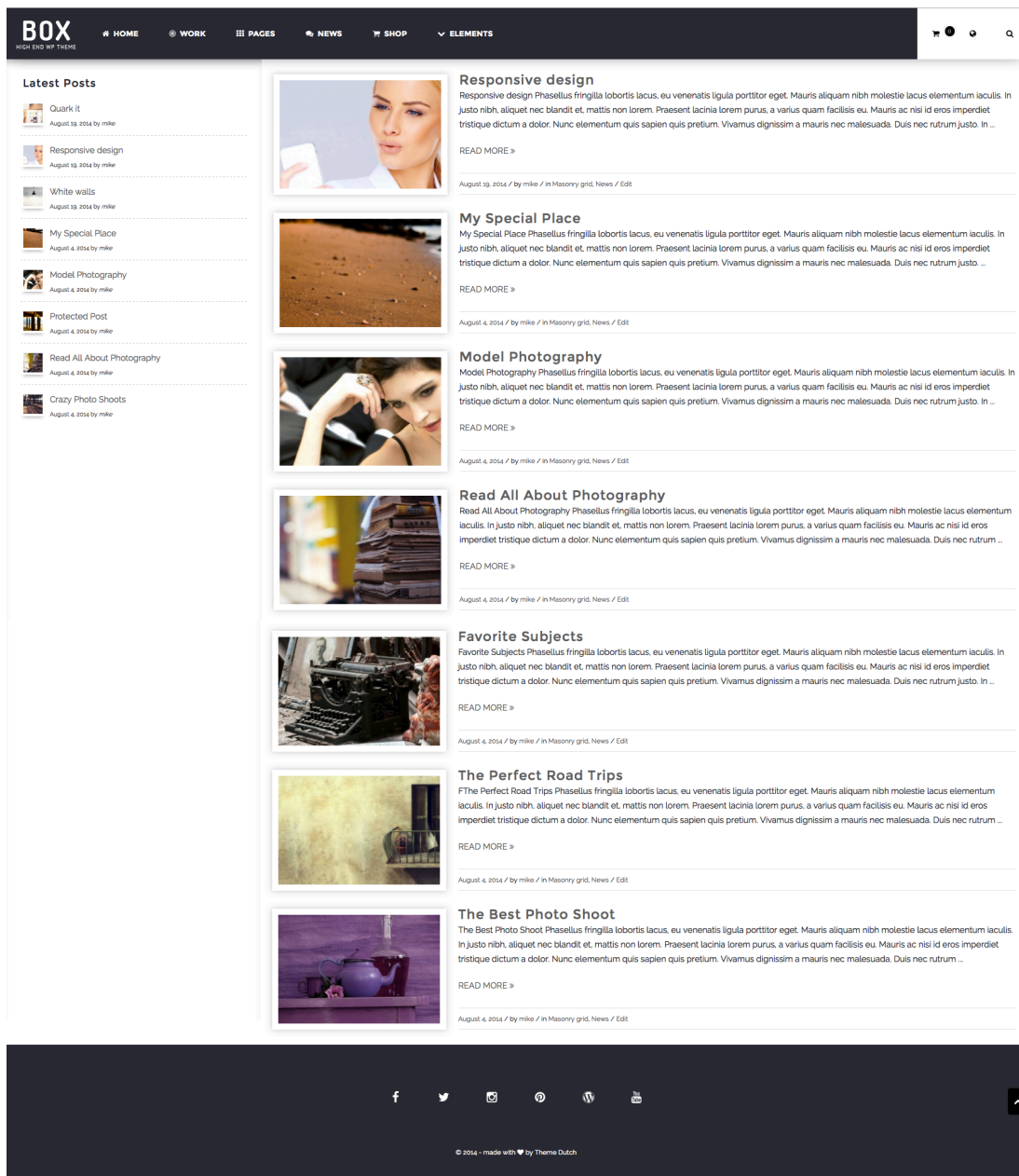

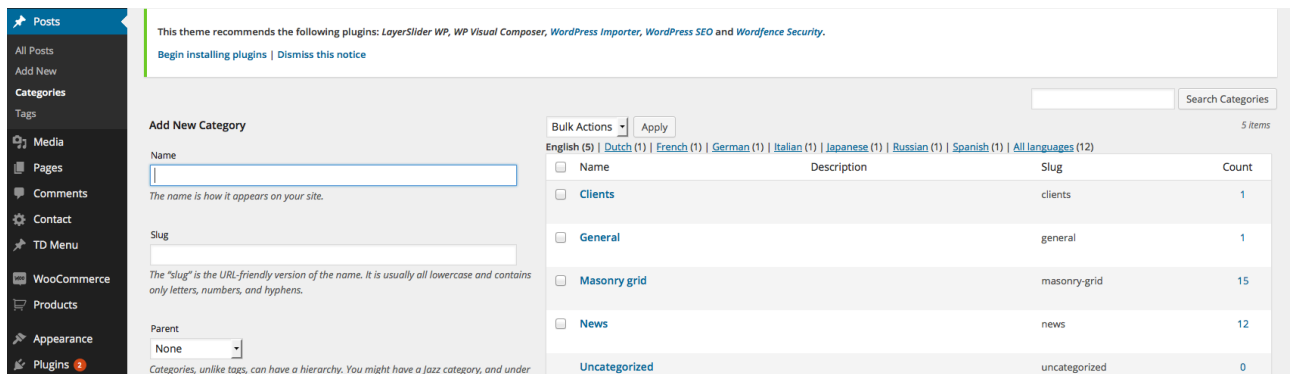

This is how a 'List Layout' looks like at the front-end of theme BOX.

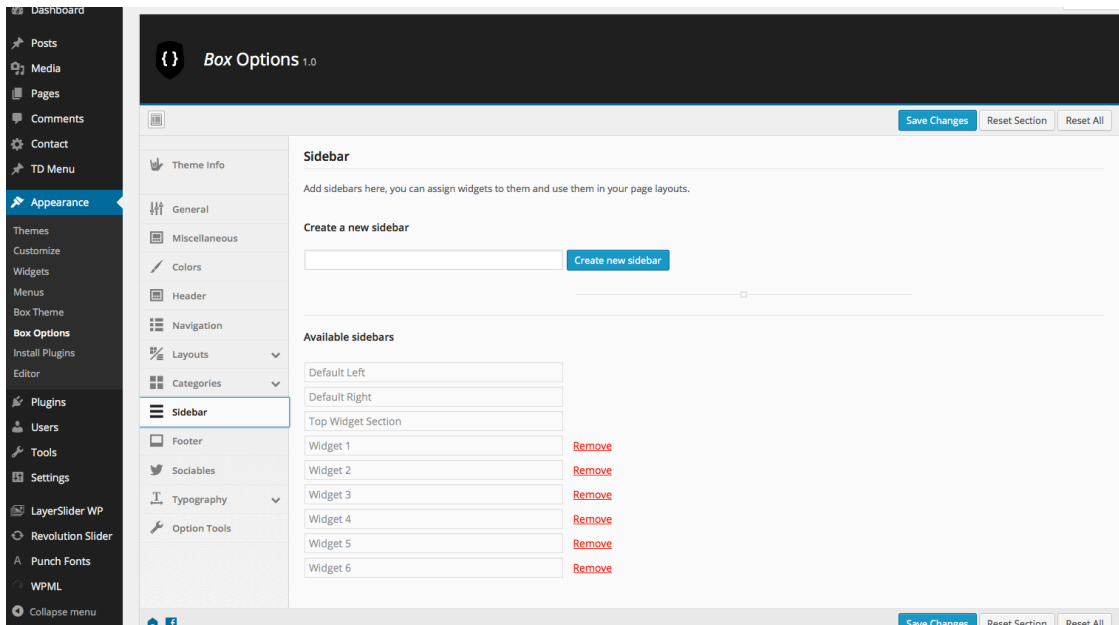

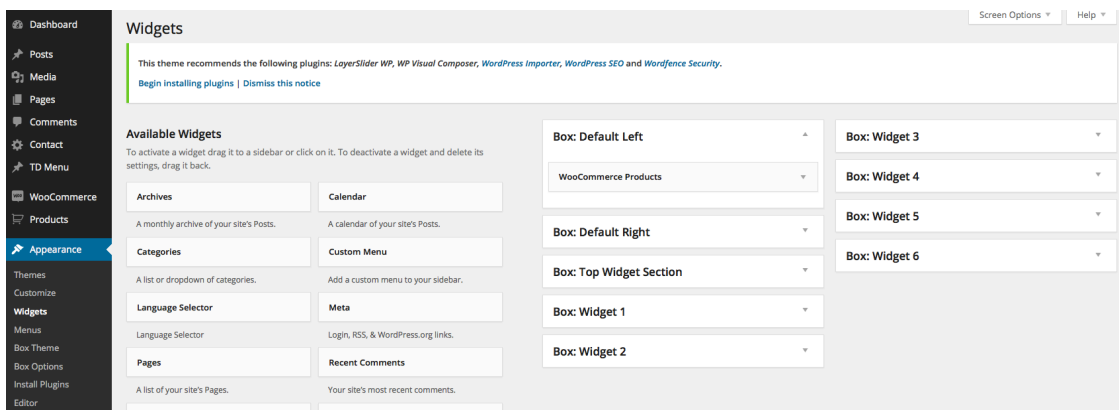


# 11. BOX Options – Sidebar

Here you're able to create your sidebar's names (for specific pages or sections), and fill them with Widgets later on via Appearance Widgets. Don't forget to hit changes once you're done.



**NOTE: Prevent using punctuations marks when creating a sidebar's title. Don't use characters like: “, : \_ and so on in your sidebars titles. Using these characters in titles can cause issues, that are not caused by the theme, but can be caused by conflicts with Msql and other used programs.**



Drag and drop the necessary widgets to your assigned sidebars at the right and fill them with text or any other html content (text, images, video's).

## 12. BOX Options – Footer: copyright link, colors

This section allows customizing the theme's Footer Colors and colors for your footer widget area. Here you also can add your Copyright link. All settings are self-explanatory.

We've already explained how to set/change colors in chapter 06. **BOX Options – Colors: customize colors.**

## 13. BOX Options – Sociables: enter links and colors

Use this tab to define custom social media links if you wish to add social media accounts to your website. In here, you can specify your account URL, Icon link color, Icon background color, and Icon background hover color.

**URL:** this is the full URL or link of your (per example) twitter account.

You should input the full URL here.

**Do this:** <https://twitter.com/themedutch>.

**Don't do this:** themedutch.

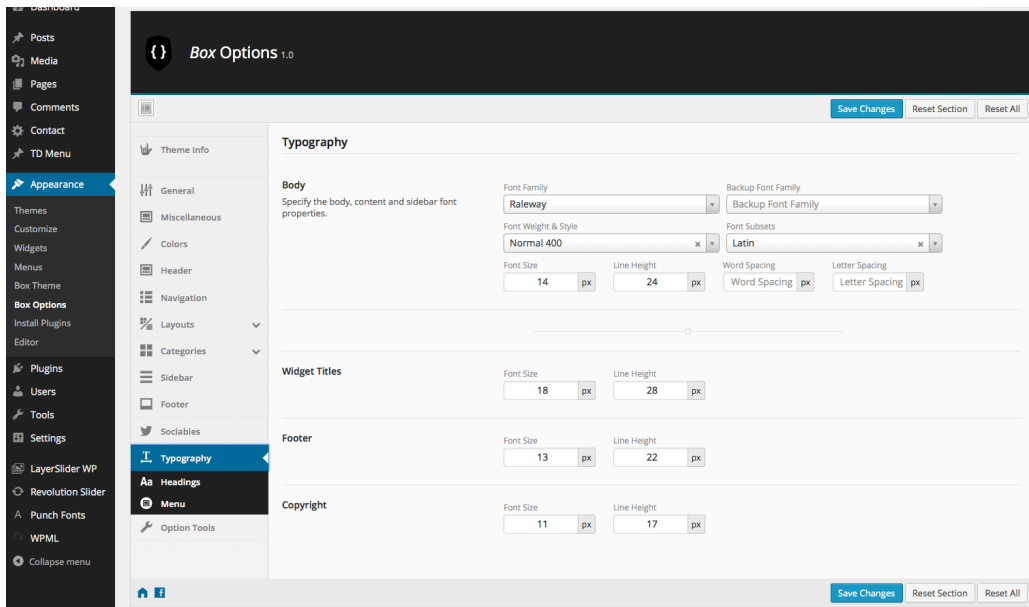
For all these options to take effect, click the **Save changes** button.

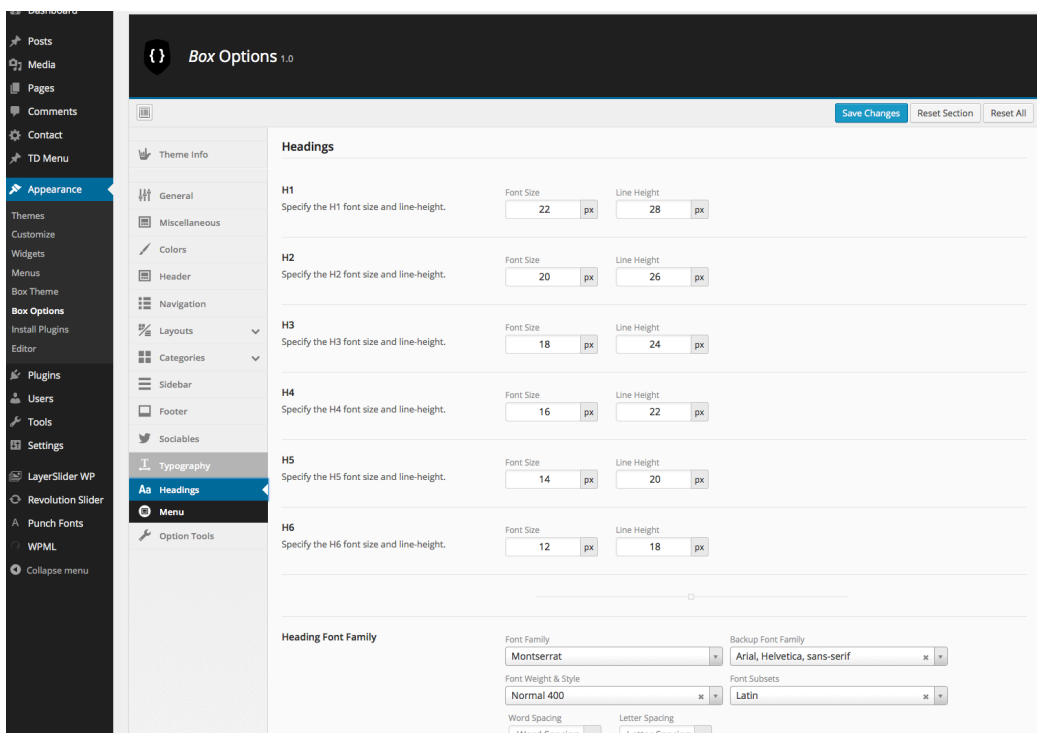
# 14. BOX Options – Typography: set/change fonts and font sizes

In here you can change the theme’s body typography, and set or change font sizes for your Body, Widget Titles, Footer, and Copyright.

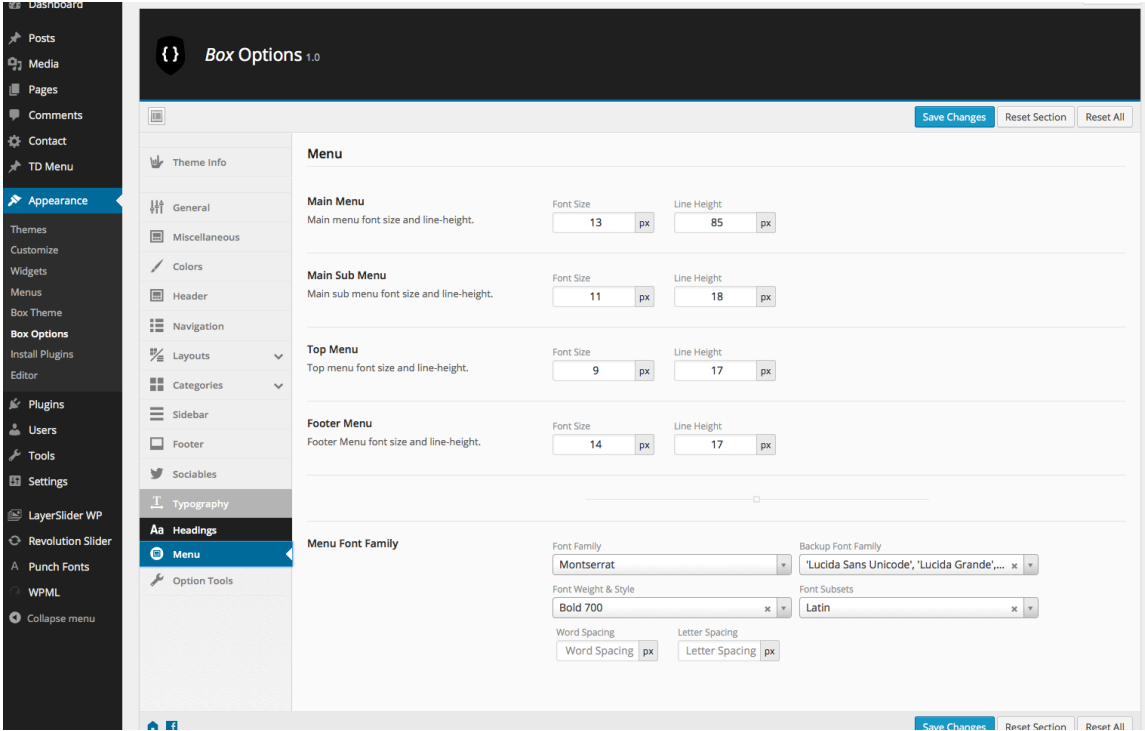
Via Line Heights you’re able to adjust line heights to your own likings.



Via the tab 'Headings' you’re able to specify the Font, font sizes and Line Heights for your headings. You’re also able to specify spacing for Words and Letters.



Via the Tab Menu, you're able to set font sizes for your Main menu, Main Sub Menu, Top Menu and Footer Menu.



## 15. BOX Options – Option Tools

The Tab Option Tools is created for importing Dummy Content, and/or export your BOX theme options from file, text or URL.


### ‘Import Dummy content’

Hit the button ‘Install Dummy Content’ if you would like to install the official BOX preview website’s content.


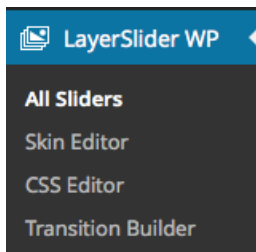


## 16. The LayerSlider (LayerSlider plugin)

For creating a slider by using this jQuery Slider plugin, you'll have to enter your Wordpress dashboard and install the LayerSlider WP.

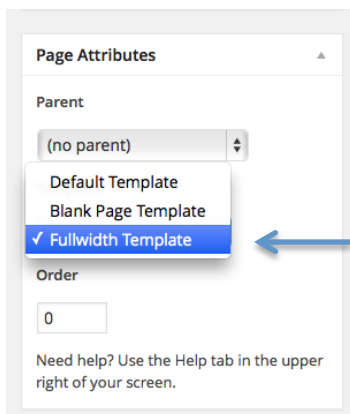


## 18. Set up Page and Post options

Options for pages and posts you'll find on your actual pages, which are accessible via your Wordpress admin panel.

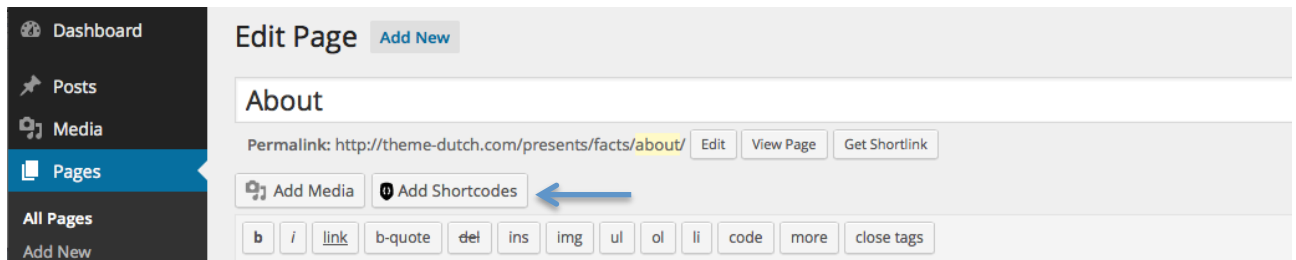


At the top of every page and post you'll find two tabs: **Add Media** and **Add Shortcodes**. Via Add Media you're able to insert your favorite images into your posts and pages. Via Add Shortcodes you're able to insert TD-shortcodes (like columns, buttons, dividers, galleries and much more), which you can use to design your layout and spice up your pages.



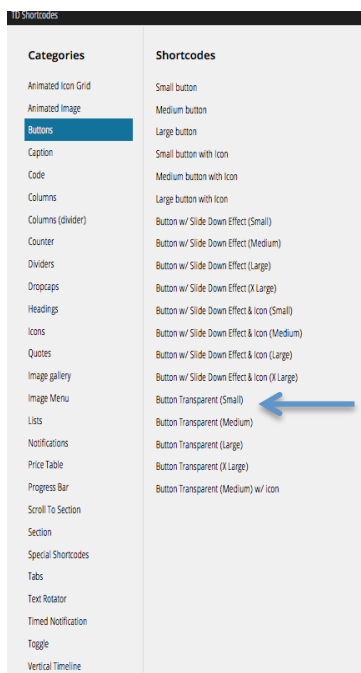
At your right hand beneath Page Attributes you have options to select your desired template into: default, blank or full width. This option is available on pages, not on post pages though.

## 19. How to use TD-shortcodes (plugin)



On the icon bar above the content block of every page or post, you'll find the TD short code manager. **(regulated via the TD-shortcode Plugin)** The TD-shortcode manager provides lots of categories and options to make us of short codes to spice up your pages and posts.

### NOTE:

Basically all TD-shortcodes work the same, and 'Live examples' of lots of short codes you'll find on BOX's Preview website. Install 'dummy content' in order to see how most TD-Shortcodes are used at the back-end.

## 20. How to use TD Menu

TD Menu is a great feature of theme BOX and enables to create a more appealing menu besides your regular main- and sub menus. This way you're able to keep your main menus simple, and attract more attention to, or promote pages of your liking with appealing images.

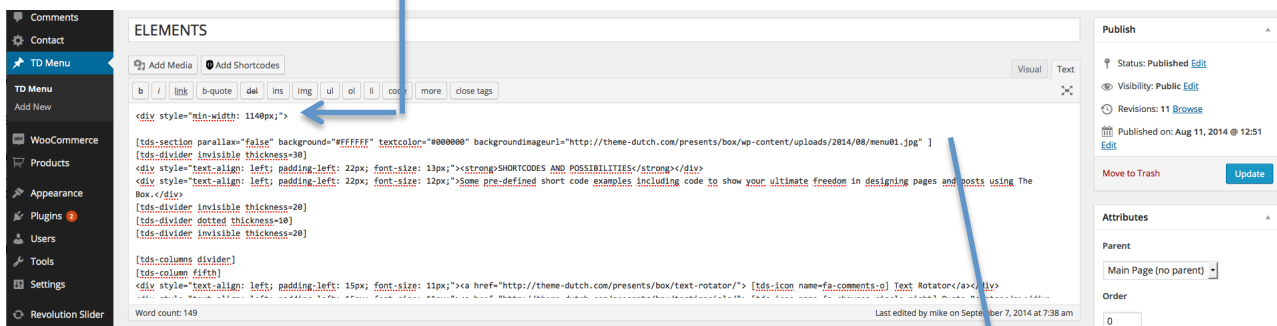


Here we explain how we've created the 'ELEMENTS' menu via TD Menu.

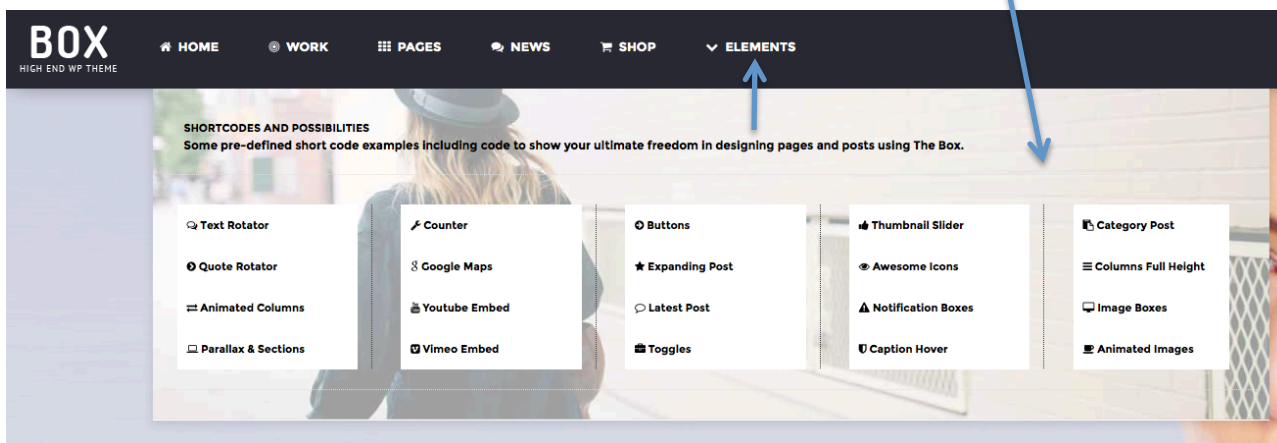
Go to your dashboard and look for TD Menu.

Adding a TD menu is very similar to creating a page. Hit add new and give your menu a name (we've used ELEMENTS), and save your menu page.

**Set the width of your menus**, and create a section (including background image if you like), some columns, text, and 'page titles' including 'links to the actual pages' in your website. Here you can see an example at the backend of BOX. Via Appearance / Menus you can add your TD Menu to you main menus.

- 6) Press ok
- 7) Poedit will ask you where to save the .po and .mo files. Choose the same folder. Name the files your language zone (example: nl-NL for the Netherlands)
- 8) Translate all the options (not all needed)
- 9) Upload the .mo and .po file to the languages folder on your website.
- 10) Change you wp-config-file with your language-code
