

Not if you own the copyright in the photograph

Secondary infringement

Knowledge of infringement

Import for non-personal use

Possess in course of business

Other contexts

Copying someone's tattoo?

Trade mark

Registered, paid-for, right

Not someone's look/image

But could trade mark elements

Aspects of costume / logo

Names?

Book / film characters

EU000935593

Status: Registered

Mark text: HARRY POTTER

Class 20

Figurines, works of art, and models made of wood, wax, plaster or plastic.

Registration does not mean all uses infringe

Identical sign, identical product

Identical sign, similar product / similar sign, identical product, plus likelihood of confusion

However...

Identical or similar sign

Mark has reputation in UK

Use of sign ... without due cause ... is detrimental to repute of mark

But only "in the course of trade"

"Personal use" non-infringing

Passing off

Unregistered trade marks

Protects goodwill / reputation

Three elements

Goodwill / reputation in sign

Misrepresentation

Misrep damages, or is likely to damage, goodwill / reputation

Irvine

False endorsement case

Use of (doctored) photo

Rihanna

Rihanna's photo on t-shirt

Not promoted as authorised

But she had done promo work with Top Shop previously

Rihanna

CoA: mere sale of a t-shirt with image of famous person is not, in itself, passing off

But was given the context here

So...

Use alone not passing off

Avoid misrep of authorisation

But I suspect people would try

In brief

Image rights: not in UK

Breach of contract: depends

Advertising complaint: perhaps

Libel: might be a stretch

Conclusion

Lots of possibilities

Will depend on the facts

Personal use less risky

All untested (AFAIK)
