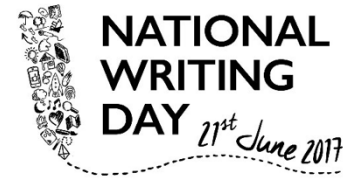


The English and Media Centre: Let Them Loose! A National Writing Day Event

Travel writing?

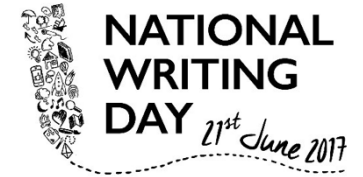
