

## How to make a flower from a recycled plastic bottle



Flowers created from recycled bottles brighten up the fence at Little Explorers Day Nursery in Rochester, Kent.

## **Materials**

- Empty 2 litre plastic bottles
- White PVA glue
- Scissors
- Waterproof marker pens

- Acrylic paints
- Paint brushes
- Fine Sandpaper
- Stickers

## Instructions:

- 1. Cut the plastic bottle one-third of the way down from the top.
- 2. Sand the bottle using fine sandpaper
- 3. Mark at least 5 "petals" using a waterproof marker.
- 4. Cut along the lines to form "petals".
- 5. Coat with a layer of white glue and let dry.
- 6. Paint and decorate the petals using acrylic paints, waterproof markers, stickers and glitter.
- 7. Poke a small hole through the bottle cap and screw the cap back onto the bottle.
- 8. Put a nail or screw through the hole to fix the flower to your fence or wall
