<i>Dark berry fruit and earthy notes are wrapped up neatly in a supple structure with the classic floral tones of Fleurie to complete the picture.</i>			
L'Elegance de Chateau Grand Ormeau, Lalande de Pomerol, Bordeaux, France, 2014			45
<i>Intense in the nose. Leather, dark red fruits such as blackberries and ripe plums. Structured on the palate with medium tannins. Medium finish.</i>			
Pinot Noir, Crittenden Estate, Mornington Peninsula, Australia, 2015			45
<i>Savoury cherry and wild plums. These remain on the soft and supple palate, along with sweet baking spices and more creamy red fruit.</i>			
Old Vine Garnacha 'El Terroir' Domaines Lupier, Navarra, SPAIN, 2014			48
<i>This wine is made from 100% Garnacha grapes which adds great complexity and concentration to a wine.</i>			
Bourgogne-Haut Cotes de Nuits, Michele & Patrice Rion, Burgundy, France, 2016			55
<i>A fresh, fruit-driven Burgundy from vineyards just above Nuits-St Georges. It is raised exclusively in used oak, which rounds the tannins and accentuates the wild, spicy character redolent of Nuits.</i>			
Merlot, Frog's Leap, Rutherford, Napa Valley, U.S.A., 2015			70
<i>Rare, fine, age-able and perfect with cuisine that requires a wine of subtlety and strength, well balanced and has a delicate herbal edge with very fine tannins</i>			
Saint Joseph 'Silice' Domaine Coursodon, Rhône Valley, FRANCE 2017			70
<i>The aromas of fresh, but ripe red and black fruits, nose of this wine evolves in this wine laced with wild berries, anise, raw and smoked meats, and herbs of provence</i>			
Rojo Reserva, 'Vina Tondonia', Lopez de Heredia, Rioja, SPAIN, 2006			75
<i>Characteristics of sweet strawberries and leather, wonderful complexity with supremely integrated hints of vanilla and that warming, autumnal feel.</i>

<i>A blend of 56% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon and 9% Malbec, it's a sweetly fruited, supple, downright sexy red that offers loads of cassis, graphite, liquorice and hints of leafy herbs. Big, ripe & concentrated.</i>
