TO INSPIRE FUTURE GENERATION

Our curriculum is designed to ensure that all students have the opportunity to achieve their maximum potential. Student groupings vary across subjects and year groups, giving maximum flexibility to accommodate each individual's needs.

Students with learning difficulties are A range of options are available to them inassisted by the Learning Support team, with specialist teachers and assistants working to support them utilising a range of strategies. Students who have a special skill or ability in a particular area are encouraged to perform to the highest level.

KEY STAGE 3 - YEARS 7 AND 8

All students in Year 7 and 8 study the full range of National Curriculum subjects, as well as a varied and interesting programme of PSCHE (Personal, Social, Citizenship and Health Education).

KEY STAGE 4 - YEARS 9, 10 AND 11

All students in Years 9, 10 and 11 study the core curriculum of English, Maths and Science.

CELEBRATING SUCCESS AND REWARDS

Staindrop Academy is passionate about celebrating success and our positive rewards system is one way we do this. Whilst education and success are at the heart of everything that we do, we also value and recognise our students who try their best and who are ambassadors for the school.

Students who gain the most positive points and those who excel academically, practically and show a positive attitude are recognised through achievement and celebration assemblies.

Our system is designed to reward every individual student for their contributions to the life of the academy. They can be recognised for any of the reasons shown below and will be given achievement points that are collated as a running total throughout the year.

Examples of the types of behaviours which earn achievement points are: punctuality, correct uniform, correct equipment, positive attitude, setting examples, excellent effort, voluntary work, extra-curricular clubs, enthusiasm, determination, perseverance, additional tasks, supporting others, outstanding work, progress over time being above target, marked improvement, quality of work and independent learning.


