LITTLE LAMBS TOPIC-How Babies Learn

Staff members learnt lots of new ideas from another setting and were very excited to share their experiences. The baby room have developed a new approach to their topics and ensure they are basic and easy to follow through.

We now do a topic a day and decide what to put into practice through parent input and the children's interests. The children have responded well to this new style of planning and have been enjoying a variety of exciting and engaging adult and child-led activities. The children particularly enjoyed the topic of water, and explored ice, watching it turn from a solid mass to a liquid.



DUCKLINGS TOPIC- Exploring Mini-Beasts!

One of our parents sent us pictures of a beehive they built in their garden. We showed the pictures to the children and talked about what animal lives in beehives and what happens in a hive. The Ducklings did a topic on mini-beasts, learning about the different types and where they live.



The children enjoyed exploring activities with mini-beasts in tuff-trays and craft activities, where they got to make their own mini-beasts. The parent sent us a video of when they had honey bees and we discussed why bees buzz, and how they make honey.

The children have been learning about the World Cup and some of the countries involved this year. The children have carried out many activities such as making flags, designing their very own football shirts and had a super penalty shoot-out. **GOALLILLILL!**



They explored different foods from countries such as England, Portugal, Spain and Germany. The children loved tasting the flavours and textures. We have also used ICT to watch goal celebrations from the World Cup and looked at different football stadiums.
