

Oscar Bears Day Care - Lost child procedure

Introduction

Oscar Bears Day Care takes the safety of the children within our care very seriously and many procedures have been put in place to ensure that a child does not leave unaccompanied. Staff do periodic head counts throughout the day, in the unlikely event that a child is unaccounted for the following procedure will apply.

Step one

- Staff will remain calm.
- Staff will inform management.
- Staff will ensure that ratios of the children in our care are maintained.
- Staff will thoroughly search the nursery, including the garden area and the immediate outside area looking up and down the lane.
- Staff will ascertain who saw the child last and where.
- Staff will ask the children, without causing any undue panic, if they have seen the child.

Usually a child could be accounted for. If the child cannot be accounted for the following procedure will apply. <u>Step two</u>

- The parents of the child will be informed.
- The police will be called on 999.
- During this time staff will continue to remain calm, look for the missing child and maintain ratios.
