

Khadafy Washington Project Program Coordinator

Youth ALIVE!'s programs are: Caught in the Crossfire, a crisis response and intensive case management program for youth and young adults hospitalized with violent injuries, Teens on Target, a school-based peer education, leadership and advocacy program, and the Khadafy Washington Project(KWP), a homicide crisis response and support program.

Job Description: This position is responsible for the coordination and administration of intervention and follow-up services provided by *Khadafy Washington Project*, a support service to anyone who has lost a child or other loved one to violence, providing intensive family support services & mentoring to youth involved in violence, as well as the field training of program staff, resource development and report writing.

Job Responsibilities

Intervention/Crisis Support: 40%

- Provide intensive family support services, mentoring and advocacy to families of homicide victims;
- Provide client referrals to community service providers such as Victim Compensation Board and funeral arrangements;
- Maintain intensive follow-up contact with clients/families through frequent home visits and telephone contact;
- Coordinate with Violence Interrupter Team (internal partnership)
- Provide grief counseling;
- Facilitate monthly support group

Documentation: 20%

- Document consistently and accurately in written and computerized records all contacts with clients;
- Oversee maintenance and update of KWP internal databases
- Oversee weekly documentation of Crisis Response Support Network (CRSN) meeting notes
- Monitor Oakland Unite data entry;

External Communications: 25%

- Monitor the CRSN emergency hotline number (24/7);
- Coordinate first response after homicide;

- Communicate with appropriate City agencies to optimize coordination
- Research, develop and maintain relationships with community service providers to secure additional resources for program participants;
- Attend & participate weekly case conferencing meetings with our partners;
- Oversee collaboration with agencies/projects to promote healing for program participants

Program Development: 15%

- Supervise crisis responders
- Supervise student interns (if applicable)
- Participate in field training;
- Participate in bi-weekly all staff meetings;
- Facilitate bi-weekly team meetings;
- Represent Khadafy Washington Project/Youth ALIVE! at community meetings and participate in violence prevention efforts with other providers as assigned;
- Represent Youth ALIVE! to the media, public officials, community leaders, etc. on strategies to prevent gun violence and improve services to youth;
- Other responsibilities as assigned by supervisor.

Qualifications:

- Strong case management experience required;
- Demonstrated commitment to working with youth and families;
- Knowledge of urban youth issues, specifically youth violence;
- Demonstrated ability to work independently and as part of a team;
- Ability to take constructive criticism and work well with supervision;
- Ability to work well with diverse populations;
- Punctual & extremely reliable;
- Highly organized and detail-oriented;
- Must be able to present self and program in a professional manner;
- Flexibility to work some evenings & weekends;
- Ability to work in stressful situations;
- High School Diploma or GED required; B.A.or B.S. preferred;
- Must have reliable car, insurance and DMV clearance;
- Applicants with personal experience in overcoming violence/ violence-related injuries/ the criminal justice system are encouraged to apply.
