

RESCUE AT HEIGHT THEME PARKS



HEIGHTWORKS TRAINING

Duration: 1 Day.

Audience: Any person who may have to perform a rescue to evacuate an incapacitated person to a point of safety whilst working at height.

Course Aim: To provide enough practical experience and education to competently perform an evacuation of an incapacitated climber from a structure.

Syllabus:

- Pre Use inspection of a rescue system
- Attachment to Anchor points
- Attachment to Casualty
- Adjustment of rescue system
- Lifting a Casualty
- Lowering a Casualty
- Understanding suspension intolerance

Prerequisites: Suitable work at height qualification/experience.
Reasonable level of health, fitness and aptitude.

Max. Ratio: 6 Delegates to 1 Instructor.

Certification Expiry: This certificate is valid for a maximum of 1 year.

Throughout the course, the student will be continually assessed and expected to complete a written and practical examination.

Only on successful completion of the whole course and examination will the candidate be issued with a certificate of competency.
