To start with: Jzk. Again, thank you for your £1 contribution in the last month. What did your money achieve?

We provided two widows with a sewing machine each so that they can provide for themselves and their children after the deaths of their husbands who were the only breadwinners in the household.

This gives women the independence and the means to provide for their children. It also means two women are not finding themselves in a dire and desperate situation simply to survive.

We also purchased one food parcel to feed a widow and her children for one whole month. A food parcel is a valuable lifeline when a family loses the breadwinner of the house to an accident. illness other circumstances. How else would a widow feed herself when she has no money and no resources? We had a choice of 16 Muslim countries such as Bangladesh, Somalia, Pakistan, Kashmir, Indonesia but we selected "where it is most needed at this time". as we want to help a family that are in imminent need.

Next months focus

In line with this month and the Islamic teachings of compassion, generosity and selflessness we will be looking into a project to feed the hungry and the poor.

We really need more people contributing to our pound projects and so a plea: please could you inform family and friends about our monthly projects so that we can help more people each month.
