In English we will study an abridged version of English 'Charlie & The Chocolate Factory' by Roald Dahl. We will develop our knowledge of characterisation and writing short stories with characters that have character flaws.

The children's SPaG skills will continue to be developed during our daily 'basic skills', phonics and spelling sessions.

Religious Education
