Every month a group of ladies meet together as Women of the Word. Penny Eldridge is one of the organisers of these meetings and tells us about the monthly breakfasts:

Once a month, 50 or so ladies between 18 and 80, get together to share food, companionship and to discover a deeper walk with Jesus. Held on the first Saturday of the month, our venue alternates between Heatherside and St John's Church Cove.

The format is simple. After a buffet breakfast there is a time of sharing followed by worship in the form of two or three hymns or songs. A talk is then given by a visiting speaker and prayer ministry is available at the end.

We are not part of any organisation, just a home grown interdenominational community that is evolving through friendship and a shared desire to discover more about God. We are big on scripture, which is why we chose to call ourselves Women of the Word, and ask our speakers to inspire us by revealing the power contained within His Word. Many of our speakers have their own ministries and can draw on years of experience. We are very privileged that some are international speakers and authors who value the opportunity of sharing the Word with us.



We charge £5 simply to cover costs of hall hire, food and a donation to speakers, many of whom travel long distances to be with us – as indeed do many of our ladies who have formed firm friendships over the three years we have been running.
