## The Menu



#### VERBAL REASONING

Here candidates are required to interpret written instructions in the style of standard operating procedures. The language is specifically tailored to the manufacturing environment.



#### NUMERICAL REASONING

This test analyses candidates' ability to work with numbers and analyse numerical data. The language is specifically tailored to the manufacturing environment.



#### **ASSEMBLY ABILITY**

Here candidates are required to assemble a number of parts within a time limit. Candidates are issued with visual instructions to help guide them through the assembly.



#### **ASSEMBLY USING A TOOL**

This test involves using tweezers to move or manipulate small objects.



#### THREADING SKILLS

Here candidates are required to thread wires a number of times within a time limit. This test is similar to pushing a thread through the eye of a needle multiple times.



### **OUALITY DETECTION**

In this test candidates are presented with a number of components and are required to identify poor quality materials either visually or by touch/feel.

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
