#### Age as at 1st January 2020.

Trophies and cups must be returned one month before the feis to Ms Antoinette Power (Tel. 086 8530572) and trophy and cup winners are liable for any loss or damage that occurs whilst the trophy or cup is in their possession.

All objections must be lodged before results are called - Objections must be made by a teacher along with objections fee €10.

The adjudicator's decision is final on all matters. The decision of the feis organiser will be final on all matters not provided for in these rules.

The feis organiser reserves the right to amend the programme and to substitute the published adjudicators should the need arise. The feis organiser reserves the right to refuse admission. Strictly no alcohol in the function rooms. The use of stools is prohibited.

The feis organiser reserves the right to refuse admission. Strictly no alconol in the function rooms. The use of stools is prohibited Costume changing is not permitted in public areas or the function rooms and dancers must be properly attired at all times.

White laces are permitted in poms from January 2019.

The use of any type of camera during competitions is forbidden. Photographs may be taken during prize-giving.

Class costumes must be worn for A, B and C grade competitions in all ages and pre-open and open competitions up to and including age under 9. Children up to and including age 12 are prohibited from wearing make-up. All dancers are prohibited from wearing glitter on face.

All competitors must wear their number positioned centre front only, clearly displayed for the adjudicators.

To be eligible to compete in Championship, competitors <u>must</u> have competed in at least one open solo competition excluding treble reel and solos in Championship

Confined competitions up to and including under 9 will be danced under one adjudicator only.

Confined competitions up to and including U/9 should exclude those who win the championship cup in those age groups. A dancer is <u>not</u> debarred from a confined competition until such time as they win a championship cup competition. Once a dancer wins a championship cup up to and including U/9, they cannot dance a confined championship until they reach U/10.

Sashes and cups for 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> prize winners in open championships (Girls & Boys). Cups for 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> prize winners in confined competitions and cup competitions and sashes for 1<sup>st</sup> place.
