The Woodstock Byrdcliffe Guild invites you to participate in its Annual Members' Show, this year called ***Untitled (Members' Show), 2019***, which runs from February 1 to March 24, 2019.

The show is open to all current members. A Curator's Choice award in the amount of \$100, plus the opportunity to represent Byrdcliffe in Family of Woodstock's Bi-annual Guitar Sculpture Exhibition, will be presented to one artist chosen by the Exhibition Committee. The opening reception is always a lively community event.

Artwork pick-up: Sun., March 24, 6:00–7:00 pm and Tues., March 26, 12:00–6:00 pm

SHOW GUIDELINES

1. *Untitled (Members' Show), 2019* is open to all current members. Those wishing to join or renew their membership can do so at drop off, or online at www.woodstockguild.org (click on "Support Byrdcliffe" in the navigation at left).
2. Spatial limits per artist are 48" high x 48" wide x 12" deep. Artists may submit one two- or three-dimensional work up to that size, or 2 works which, combined, would fit into an imaginary 48" x 48" box. No exceptions, please.
3. All work must have been created within the last 5 years.
4. All work must be for sale (no NFS). Prices should include 40% commission to Byrdcliffe.
5. All artists must submit a signed Exhibition Agreement (included with this mailing).
6. If submitting jewelry, you must bring your own display case, please.
7. All work to be hung must be wired securely and ready to hang. Wet work will not be accepted.
8. Works left beyond appointed pick-up dates will incur a \$5 storage fee per day.

Volunteers are requested to help with the following (please contact derin@woodstockguild.org to sign up for a few hours):

- Receive works on drop-off day, Tuesday, January 29, between 11:00 am and 7:00 pm.
- Sign artworks out on pick-up day, Tuesday, March 26, between 12:00 and 6:00 pm.
