



Ropulplat - Spain

In 2005 VCU Europa was commissioned to build an In-Vessel composting facility for Ropulpat SL.

Located in Burgos Spain, Ropulpat's primary business focuses on the treatment and land spreading of organic sludges.

As a registered transporter of animal-by products (ABP), Ropulpat SL saw the development of the VCU composting facility as a strategic move into the treatment of ABP which were formally contracted to other treatment plants (including incineration and rendering) for processing.

The VCU100 facility processes 5000 tonnes per annum, composting ABP waste such as bone, blood, feathers and hair. The VCU plant has been built to allow easy expansion to 10000 tonnes per annum.

Ropulpat selected VCU technology after reviewing European suppliers of composting equuipment, citing VCU's proven performance in treating ABP waste and the fact the company was already established in Spain as leading factors in their decision.
