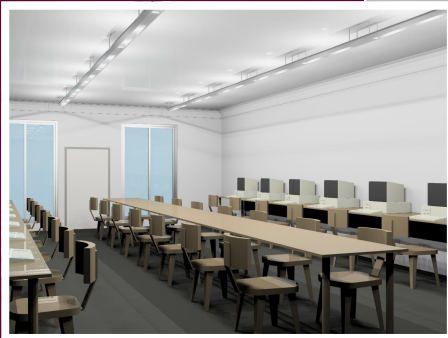


# Refurbishment of existing premises into a special teaching facility for Burnage Media Arts College

## The Project

Burnage Media Arts College decided to take a lease on 446 Didsbury Road with the idea of refurbishing it to provide facilities for year 10 & 11 students. They developed initial ideas and employed Wilcox Construction Services to develop the scheme

further, manage the planning and building regulations and subsequent construction and refurbishment.

The budget was set at £71k. Many of the materials were re-used from the recent strip out of the BSF school works to save costs and reduce impact on the

environment.

The actual costs were £71k including all IT equipment and installations. The school achieved an estimated saving on construction development costs in the order of £100k and completed the project with only 5 weeks on site.
