

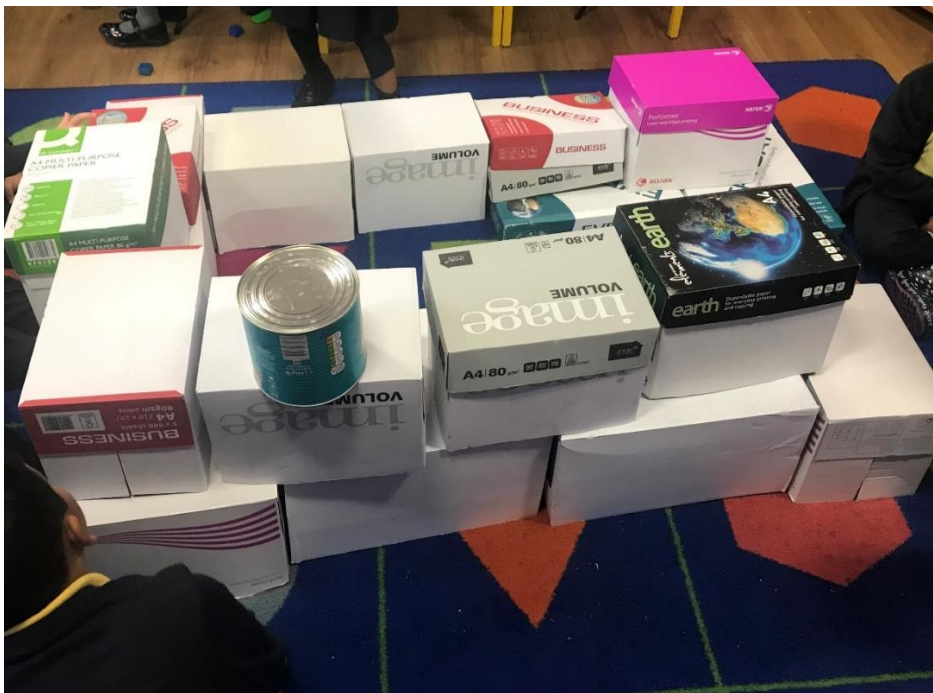
For Design and Technology, we worked as a team to construct the British Hotel that Mary Seacole ran in 1854 during the Crimean war

We constructed several models of the hospital.



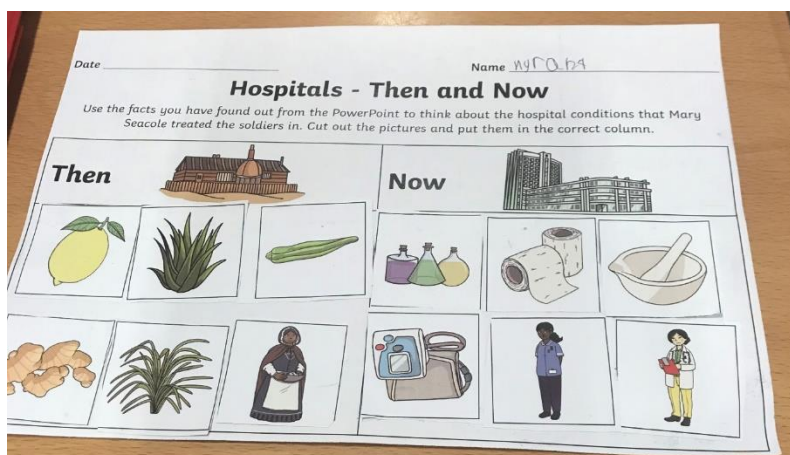
.We made the British Hotel by recycling old boxes.

Ingredient	Information
 <u>Lemon grass</u>	This was used to help <u>fever</u> . Mary would <u>boil</u> with water in a <u>pan</u> .
 <u>Ginger</u>	This was used to help <u>diarrhoea</u> . Mary would <u>crush</u> it with a <u>pestle</u> and <u>mortar</u> .
 <u>Okra</u>	This was used to help heal <u>boils</u> . Mary would <u>chop</u> it with a <u>knife</u> .
 <u>Aloe vera</u>	This was used to help heal <u>cuts/wound</u> . Mary would <u>mix</u> it in a <u>bowl</u> .
 <u>Lemon</u>	This was used to help <u>coughs</u> . Mary would <u>Mix</u> it in a <u>bowl</u> .
