Survey on the Young Affluent in Hong Kong

The survey, with a qualitative - not quantitative – approach, aimed at perceiving the young affluent approach on luxury (their understanding of products, services, future shops) and how they see themselves when compared to their elder ones. It focused on the Hong Kong young affluent (18-25.y.o), to understand what luxury is for them and how they will consume in the short to medium-term future.
