#### LEARN TO BE LIBERATED

Date: Saturday, 6th May 2017

This is going to be a fun workshop. Liberated quiltmaking is exactly what is says on the tin – liberating!! No need to worry about exact measurements or matching everything in sight – you are going to be creating your own individual pieces of work using some improvisational techniques.

We have three quilts to inspire you and Ileana will be teaching three techniques for you to make blocks. Each of the blocks could be the beginning of a quilt or you could create a quilt using all the different blocks. The choices are endless and you will come away inspired.

Just bring your quilting essentials (thread, scissors, needles, pins etc) and a fat guarter bundle (or its equivalent) with you to the workshop. Class involves machine sewing.

#### ENGLISH PAPER PIECING

Date: Saturday, 20th May 2017

This is an introduction to English paper piecing which is our very own traditional method of patchwork. Come and be totally inspired by Sarah's beautiful quilt. Familiarise yourself with this relaxing method of patchwork sewn by hand and learn how to use the different shapes Sarah has used in her quilt.

A totally chilled out day not to be missed with an heirloom guilt in the making. Class involves hand work.

#### LITTLE GEM

Date: Saturday, 27th May 2017

Cost: £42 **Tutor: Margaret** 

This quilt will feature the simple and versatile block 'Puss in the Corner'. The block will be set on diagonal alternating with a plain block making the guilt interesting and guick to put together.

A good quilt for beginners or someone that knows what they are doing but wish to make a lovely quick quilt.

Class involves rotary cutting and machine piecing.

# INTRO TO HAND QUILTING FOR THE TERRIFIED

Date: Saturday, 3rd June 2017

This course is designed for those who are already familiar with basic quilting terminology/techniques and who have balked at the prospect of hand quilting their work.

This is a day to encourage you to relax and simply have a go. Class involves hand sewing.

# MAKE A TUFFET (1½ day course)

Date: Friday, 9th June (10-1) and Friday, 30th June 2017

(10-4) Cost: £70

**Tutor: Pam/Nicky** 

Spend the first half day learning the technique on how to make your tuffet panels using foundation piecing. We'll show you tips/tricks and little gadgets to make it easier.

At home, you will finish making all the tuffet panels ready for the second day where we will be putting your tuffet together.

By the end of the second day you will have a finished tuffet! Class involves machine sewing and a little hand sewing too.

# MAKE A SPEEDY TUFFET (2 day course)

Date: Saturday, 10th June and Sunday, 11th June 2017

(10-4 both days) Cost: £100 Tutor: Pam/Nicky

We will be making a tuffet which you will have finished on the Sunday. We will be working with either double width tuffet strips or single width plus a larger strip so that the tuffet process speeds up and you can complete your tuffet in a weekend.

On the first day we will focus on making your tuffet top and on the second day we wall show you how to put your tuffet together! Class involves machine sewing and a little hand sewing too.

#### INTRODUCTION TO FOUNDATION PIECING TASTER DAY

Date: Saturday, 17th June 2017

Cost: £45 - fabrics & wadding provided

Tutor: Ileana

If you would like to try your hand at foundation piecing, then this is a great class to attend. It is a super technique to learn that will enable you to create intricate designs easily. The class is aimed at beginners although even if you have tried your hand at it before, you will learn tips and ideas which will inspire.

We will supply the fabrics and wadding for you to use on the day so you will have a small project to take home with you. Class involves machine sewing.

**SKILL LEVEL:** All the classes are suitable for quilters of all skill levels. If you are a complete beginner, then do come along - you will be made to feel extremely welcome and you will be well looked after.

**INFO:** Classes are held in our studio located behind our shop, 37-39 High Street, Dorking, Surrey, RH4 1AR. Classes run from 10-3.30 (unless otherwise stated). Morning and afternoon refreshments are provided (half day courses/precut club will receive morning refreshments). You can bring a packed lunch or buy something from the town.

**WHAT'S PROVIDED:** We have Janome sewing machines available to use free of charge (or you can, of course bring your own). We also provide cutting mats. In some of our taster days, we provide the fabric but please check the class requirements list to see what you need.

#### FLYING GEESE QUILT

One of patchwork's classic patterns. This is fun to make a joy to own. Suitable for any size quilt from baby to king size and looks great in all fabrics. A perfect quilt for a jelly roll too!

This is a new technique class following on from the success of Ileana's previous Traditional and Improvisational class last

Ileana will introduce three additional improvisational techniques for you to make blocks. Each of the blocks could be the beginning of a quilt or you could create a quilt using all the blocks.

Just bring your quilting essentials (thread, scissors, needles, pins etc) and a fat quarter bundle (or its equivalent) with you to the workshop. Class involves machine sewing.
