Situation

Tyre recycler trading on rented land and left without removing any of the Tyres that they have amassed there (A familiar story)

Y Critical Issue

Site needed to be cleared through Environment Agency pressure and land needed to create an income for land owners. Site was currently posing a huge fire, health & safety risk.

Keason

Tyres have to be disposed of in a environmentally friendly manner and at a cost. Many companies, illegally set up Tyre recycling organisations in an irresponsible manner and soon find themselves in trouble and decide to run away from the problems and despairingly for the landlord, all the amassed Tyres.

∀ Capability (when, who, what)

Rob Morris Environmental Ltd and partners cleared the site to schedule over 7 weeks. The tyre waste was logistically managed into a large tyre reprocessing plant in 4 different locations. We cleared and reprocessed:

- 3813 Tyre Bales (Approx 400,000 waste car/van Tyres)
- 850 Loose HGV & Agricultural Tyres
- 1800 Loose Car/Van Tyres
