- Data is the facts about you that we collect from your parents / carers.
- The facts that we know about you are: your full name, your date of birth, your address, your email address, your telephone number, information about your health, your personal circumstances, your beliefs and any other relevant lifestyle factors.
- We get those facts from your parents / carers.
- We keep your data for the time that we are working with you. We also keep it after our work is finished if we need to for some other reason. If you would like to more about those reasons just ask your parents or carers.
- We use your data as part of the agreement that we have with your parents / carers to work on helping you with mentoring.
- Data gives you rights. You have the right to ask us to correct any mistakes in your data. You have the right to move your data. You have the right to ask us to delete your data. If you want to explore these rights further then tell your parents or carers and they will let us know.
