Mexican Railway can be run in a number of ways to suit specific briefs and timings. Typically, teams are provided with a number of challenges which they must complete in order to successfully earn the resources they will need to build a unique railway system. And with each team responsible for one section of the track the challenge is to finally work together to create one final rail network.

Once the whole track is built, it's time for some testing with some fun 'speed trials' before the whole group is challenged with the final goal of successfully transporting the allocated cargo around the entire track.

Mexican Railway works well at any meeting of more than twenty people, and even better at conferences with hundreds of delegates. In addition, it is flexible enough to be tailored to meet a specific need - for example, brightly coloured balls can be introduced as cargo to represent different departments within the organisation. The railway track could then represent a product cycle, a production process or the calendar year.

Mexican Railway is versatile enough to be styled around a competitive or cooperative brief and can accommodate really large numbers. Usable both indoors and outdoors, the activity can be





delivered as a fun breakout or be used as a more formal activity with additional faciliation designed to highlight specific issues such as problem solving, communication, leadership and trust between teams.
