Admissions Checklist for International Students

- ☐ Fill out and submit a completed **application** (it is free to apply). You can apply through one of the following options:
 - Common Application (commonapp.org)
 - Newbury Application (newbury.edu)
- □ A writing sample. Please submit a paper you have written within the past year. It should be a minimum of 250 words and can be on any subject. Some examples are an English composition, a history thesis, a psychology report or a literary critique. Newbury College will accept the Common Application essay in place of a graded writing sample.
- ☐ 2 **letters of recommendation** (from a counselor or teacher)
- ☐ **Transcript**(s)
- □ **TOEFL** or **IELTS** scores. A minimum TOEFL score of 71 (internet); 197 (computer); or a 527-530 (paper) is required. A 5.5 band score is required on the IELTS.
- ☐ **SAT/ACT** optional
- ☐ **AP/IB scores** if available

» Enrollment Checklist

- □ Enrollment deposit
 - \$1,000 (if living in the residence halls)
 - or \$500 (if living off campus)
 - Note: All first year international students are guaranteed oncampus housing if desired.
- ☐ Submit the following documents (links to documents for international students can be found at newbury.edu/admissionsandaid/
 - 1. Declaration & Certification of Finance
 - 2. Original letter of support from the sponsor's bank
 - 3. Copy of passport
 - 4. Transfer Verification Form (only if currently studying in the U.S.)
 - 5. Copy of visa (only if currently studying in the U.S.)
 - 6. Copy of I-94 card (only if currently studying in the U.S.)
 - 7. Copy of current I-20 form (only if currently studying in the U.S.)
