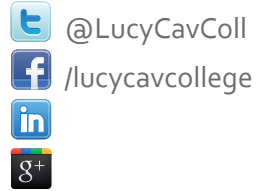

Pioneers in postgraduate education

The very first resident student at Lucy Cavendish was a postgraduate mathematician from the United States, who began her PhD with us in 1966.

We have retained our commitment to graduate education and internationalism since then, and now have more than 230 postgraduate students, from more than 60 countries.

We pride ourselves on the academic and pastoral support we offer women on postgraduate programmes.

Students on some taught courses have designated Directors of Studies, who provide guidance on subject matters and monitor academic progress. All students have a College Tutor, to advise on personal matters, including career planning, and our tutorial team contains a number of trained coaches and mentors, who work together to deliver postgraduate skills workshops throughout the academic year.

We take every opportunity to showcase the achievements of our postgraduates.

Lucy Cavendish students work at the cutting edge of everything from urban design to diabetes management, and our College provides a platform for them to talk about that work: at regular seminars and an annual research day, and via our website and social media accounts.

Financial assistance for students is one of our highest priorities.

Lucy Cavendish already offers a range of scholarships for postgraduates, and we are working with partners and donors to ensure that our tuition and maintenance awards make a meaningful difference to students' lives. We also make grants to offset the cost of research-related travel and attendance at conferences.

Postgraduates are fully integrated into our College community.

We have a single Students' Union, uniting women at every stage of their studies, and many of our postgraduate students live on the main College campus. Our academic staff build 'subject networks', hosting events that bring together undergraduates, postgraduates, postdoctoral researchers, and experienced lecturers.



Our new Student Centre provides some of the highest quality accommodation available to postgraduates in Cambridge.

The Histon Road Complex, opened in 2014, contains fifty-six en suite study bedrooms and eight flats for couples and families, as well as social spaces; it is less than ten minutes' walk away from the main College site and its amenities.



Our dining hall is renowned for its fresh, seasonal cuisine and the friendly welcome it offers to guests.

We also supply food to take away, and ensure that all our students have access to well-equipped kitchens.

Our on-site facilities include a gym, a music pavilion and a spacious, study-friendly library, as well as extensive gardens.

Off-site, students enjoy success in a huge range of creative and sporting activities, from film-making and horse-riding to rowing with our trophy winning Boat Club.



We are the only College to accept applicants for every full-time course offered at Cambridge.

Lucy Cavendish admits part-time postgraduates and visiting students too, and our Admissions Office is always happy to advise prospective applicants.
