

You will require a sharp blade or knife, a squeegee, spray water bottle and a clean cloth. Ensure the film is kept clean whilst handling.

DO NOT fold or crease the film.


I. First, make sure to clean the surface with soapy water or rubbing alcohol.




3. Spray the mounting suface with plenty of very weak soapy water, this makes it easier to reposition the graphics.




5. Place the adhesive side of the vinyl on the surface you're applying the graphics to.




2. Use a knife (at your own risk) to scrape off any surface bumps or anything that is stuck to the surface that will interfere with your new graphic.




4. Seperate the backing liner from the printed vinyl.




6. When in the correct position, squeegee the film following this pattern.



7. Smooth out any imperfections or bubbles.



9. Wipe a cloth over the graphic and stand back to admire your look!



8. Trim any overlap with a stanley blade or sharp knife.
