

Commercial Sewage Treatment Plant



Where solids settle. This section will need the sludge that forms to be emptied by vacuum tanker periodically dependent on load.

This is where the effluent is treated aerobically. Air is pumped into this section by the blower. The blower can be sited within the access turret of the sewage treatment plant or in a kiosk close by.

FINAL SETTLEMENT

From here the treated effluent can be discharged by gravity to a watercourse or soak-away. A pumped outlet is available for those occasions when the watercourse or soak-away is some distance away.
