

Boma 7 Hire Terms & Conditions

Our aim is to provide hire service of the Boma 7 off-road wheelchair in road worthy condition. We are here to help make your experience more enjoyable by offering 'top end' equipment. To achieve this at reasonable cost our customers must treat the equipment responsibly.



Hoe Grange Holidays aims to maintain the serviceability of the Boma 7, but reserves the right to cancel a booking for use due to unforeseen circumstances, mechanical breakdown, weather conditions or the unsuitability of the Boma 7 for the intended user. Any such cancelation will result in a full refund of any monies paid.

Wear and Tear and General Use

The Boma 7 is designed for and must only be used by people needing assistance due to limited mobility or medical disorders. No one under the age of 14 may use the Boma 7.

You are paying for the hire of our equipment NOT absolving yourself of responsibility for damage to the Boma 7 or parts. Punctures will be repaired at the customer's expense.

Any damage caused due to crash or neglect or misuse is the customer's responsibility and will be charged for. Cosmetic damage will be charged accordingly.

You must lock the Boma 7 with the provided bike lock to an immoveable object when it is unattended and must do your best to safeguard it. Loss or theft of the Boma 7 is the customer's responsibility and will be charged for.

Only the person named on the hire agreement may ride on the Boma 7, and no children, pets, or cumbersome items that may impede the operation of the Boma 7 shall be carried.

NO ONE MUST EVER RIDE ON THE BACK OF THE BOMA 7.

It is the responsibility of the hirer to assess the suitability of the terrain and to take due care. Hoe Grange Holidays accepts no responsibility as to the suitability of local paths and trails. Users should be aware and considerate of others whilst using the Boma 7, and slow down when passing. You must stop and give way to horse riders.

Users are advised to carry a mobile phone whilst using the Boma 7 so that assistance can be called for if necessary. Hoe Grange Holidays will not be held responsible if users cannot contact them in case of emergency if no phone is carried, or no signal can be received.

Payment

The full amount of hire payment is required at the time of booking. A cancellation fee of $\pounds 20$ will be charged if the hire is cancelled less than 24 in advance of the hire period. In the event that the hire period is cut short no refund will be given for partially used hire fees.

Late return of the Boma 7 will result in a charge of £10 per hour or any part thereof.

Personal Safety

The driver is responsible for their own safety and that of third party persons or property. Using the Boma 7 off-road wheelchair involves personal risk and rider responsibility. Injury(s) and/or death associated with off-road sport may result from weather, excessive speed, collision with inanimate objects or other persons, and rider inexperience, error or abuse of equipment. Use of the Boma 7 is entirely at your own risk.

It is advisable not to use alone and the Boma 7 must not be used under the influence of alcohol, medication or drugs.
